SCHNEIDER: But --GARY: You know, I've just been handed a note 8 that David -- I guess David did a radio interview and 9 that's, that's been completed. It -- you know, I --10 how, how is he feeling with his injuries? 11 12 MR. SCHNEIDER: He said he's sore. GARY: Boy I would think he'd more than sore 13 MR. SCHNEIDER: Yeah, well, yeah, well, 14 that's what he said, he's sore and, you know, he's been 15 talking all day long. 16 17 GARY: Yeah. 18 MR. SCHNEIDER: And so far, I mean, everything -- he's doing okay. He was bleeding earlier 19 in the day but that's all been stopped and everything 20 21 80 --GARY: Well, there must, there must be a lot 22 of confusion inside. You must be --23 24 MR. SCHNEIDER: Well --25 -- all wondering what, what's happened GARY: today and (indiscernible).

1 MR. SCHNEIDER: Well, the truth of the matter 2 is --3 GARY: Yeah. MR. SCHNEIDER: -- what (indiscernible) the 4 5 very onset of the thing--GARY: Yeah. 6 7 MR. SCHNEIDER: I mean I was standing right near the front door and I had just walked a way down a 8 little ways from it when all of a sudden I heard this 10 bang, bang, bang, bang and I mean coming from the 11 outside. 12 GARY: Um-hum. 13 MR. SCHNEIDER: I heard him yelling something about, "Stop, we've got women and children here." I do remember him yelling that, I heard it very clearly. 15 And that's when I saw the walls being just ripped up 16 17 and windows and all --18 GARY: Yeah. MR. It's,

GARY: Yeah. So, how can we work to get 6 another two out? 7 MR. SCHNEIDER: Well, we can start doing that 8 even now if you would like. 9 10 GARY: Sure, I would. 11 MR. SCHNEIDER: (Indiscernible) to go on. GARY: Yeah, I really would like to do that. 12 MR. SCHNEIDER: I'm talking to Gary who has 13 replaced Jim. Jim is getting some rest right now. No one's been given 16 17 permission to do such a thing --18 GARY: Okay. 19 MR. SCHNEIDER: -- nobody. 20 GARY: Well, I have to accept your word on that, and I really -- I hope nobody's doing that 21 22 without your knowledge. 23 MR. SCHNEIDER: (Indiscernible) the dogs -there's dogs still running around he says. 24 25 GARY: Um-hum. MR. SCHNEIDER: But nobody from inside this

building, nobody has permission and nobody has done that. In fact (indiscernible) now. 2 3 GARY: Well, good, because we're, you know, we're keeping our end of the bargain and, and, and 4 trying to make sure we keep a lid on, on any activity 5 that might be misinterpreted by either side as being --6 MR. SCHNEIDER: Most definitely. 7 GARY: -- an act of aggression because we 8 just don't want that. 9 MR. SCHNEIDER: Believe -- I told you what I 10 did, I mean that. 11 GARY: Yeah. Did you get a chance to get 12 13 some, get some rest, Steve? 14 MR. SCHNEIDER: I, I was just in fact laying my head down --15 16 GARY: Um-hum. 17 MR. SCHNEIDER: All these guys though Gary, they've all told me the same thing. What am I go --23 24 GARY: No, and, and I'm concerned because I, I don't want to lose my good faith with you. MR. SCHNEIDER: Well, you know the truth is,

you know, also, they've -- they observed -- here's an Army tank over here now, armored carrier vehicle of 2 3 some sort. 4 GARY: Yeah, yeah. 5 MR. SCHNEIDER: There's this, there's that. I mean, what is this going to be World War III or what? 6 7 GARY: Well, there's a lot of people out here as you well know and, and, and you've seen the news and 8 9 you know --10 MR. SCHNEIDER: I would -- to tell you the truth, I was quite surprised. If anything, I thought 11 12 13 GARY: Yeah. 14 MR. life.

But the fifth seal is a sad thing for the world because it's a seal that talks about -- and I beheld when the lamb opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar, the souls that have been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held, crying to God, saying oh, Lord God, how long will not avenge our blood upon those who dwell upon the earth?

JIM: Hmmm.

DAVID: You see, someone died 2,000 years ago so that man can have a chance to learn the truth about condemnation. Somebody died so that man could admit they don't know what they're doing and they would listen and learn. And so, when you read the Book of John, all through the Book of John, Jim --

JIM: Yeah.

DAVID: -- it's always being said of Christ that Christ -- I can -- myself through nothing, but that which I receive of my father that I speak, for the doctrine is not mine, but it's my father's. See, they didn't understand that 2,000 years ago.

JIM: Um-hum.

DAVID: So, heaven tried to make it a little

easier this time so that John the Revelator wrote that when the Gentiles are going to be judged, it's going to be based on the same truth the Jews rejected. It's going to be according to the father giving to his son a book. So that you can now know the doctrine is not my own, it's my father's, you know. I, I do not speak of myself, but what the father has given me that I received.

JIM: Um-hum.

DAVID: And so, that's why in these symbols it's so clear that when I come in the volume of the book that's written to me, I have to show you from the writings of all the prophets what God has already told them about me. Otherwise, I'm nothing.

JIM: Yeah, I understand.

DAVID: You can't believe flesh and blood, you have to, you have to pass the test. You have to stand up to the credentials.

JIM: Um-hum.

DAVID: Now, the fifth seal, you know, in Isaiah 26, it says we have a strong city. Salvation will guard our plentiful walls and bulwarks. Yea, the lofty city, Babylon, he'll bring it down, even to the dust, for the feet of the poor and the needy shall trod it underfeet. 5 It says let David be showed to the wicked. 6 Yet, will they not learn righteousness? In the land of uprightness they would deal unjustly, for they would not behold the majesty of the Lord. Lord, when thy 9 hand is lifted up, they will not see. You know, the 10 father upholds his word, don't he? 11 Right. JIM: 12 DAVID: But they shall see and then they 13 shall be ashamed for their anger against thy people. It says Lord, we've been in pain. We've been in pain 14 15 as a woman in travail. It says we have not wrought any 16 deliverance in the earth, neither have the inhabitants 17 of the world fallen. It says but by dead men shall arise with my dead body. Awake he that dwell in the 18 dust. 19 Then --20 David --JIM: 21 I know it sounds like poetry to you, 22 doesn't it? 23 No. Listen, I just want to --24 DAVID: You all are going to kill us. 25 JIM: No, no, no.

There's a lot of 3 people here, right? 4 JIM: Right. 5 DAVID: And you all think that they believe 6 in me, right? 7 JIM: Right. 8 DAVID: But, like it says in the Gospel, he that believeth in me believeth not in me, but believeth 9 in him that sent me. 10 11 JIM: Um-hum. 12 DAVID: Okay? 13 JIM: Um-hum. 14 In other words, we cannot receive the DAVID: seal by accepting any man's flesh. We have to accept 15 the word, what's written in the book. So, the thing of 16 it is is like this. Every, every, you know, the slower 17 we make this, you understand what I'm saying? 18 19 JIM: Um-hum. 20 DAVID: The more time it gives the people here to make a decision, you know. So, you know, you 21 just may see a few adults come out, too. 22 JIM: Yeah. Oh, yeah, of course. 23 24 DAVID: You see what I'm saying? 25 JIM: Yeah. DAVID: 'Cause these people are facing

realities that, you know, what they're learned in the Prophecies is one thing, but now they're facing 2 3 reality. 4 JIM: David, you're, you're, you're a wise 5 man and --6 DAVID: Well, what I'm saying is this. saying that, you know, you know, if I go, then, then I 7 won't be around no more. 8 9 JIM: Well, listen --10 DAVID: And let me say something. 11 JIM: Okay. DAVID: 'Cause, you know, I cannot save any 12 person that respects me as a person. There's a truth, 13 you know, 'cause we're all equal in the flesh. Flesh 14 and blood does not inherit the kingdom of God. 15 16 JIM: Right. DAVID: So, you know, once I'm out of the 17 way, the people are going to have nothing to look to 18 19 but what? 20 JIM: The seven seals? 21 DAVID: What they believe, you see. that's why I don't want no medical attention, you know. 22 That's why I'm laying here in a big old pool of blood. 23 Well, it's dried up now. 24 25 I wish you'd take some medical care. DAVID: Well --

JIM: I'd like to be the one to help you get 2 it. 3 DAVID: I wish, I wish I'd gotten shot in the head. JIM: Oh, David, don't say that. 5 DAVID: Well, here's the deal, because, you 6 7 see, the truth of the word, that's what the real Messiah is. 9 JIM: Right. DAVID: You know, Moses is not the Messiah, 10 and Elijah's not, you know. Not even the body of 11 Christ, you know. All men, no matter what they may be 12 with the gift of God, they are vanity. And that's why, 13 you see, when you see even Christ on the cross, you see that, that God allows men to suffer greatly sometimes, 15 and that's why the spirit of Christ, which is the 16 spirit of all mankind, the spirit of Christ is the 17 spirit of truth. It's not just one man. It's from 18 Adam all the way to the end, all those who believe in 19 God and God's truth. So, so if I'm anything -- are you 20 21 there, Jim? 22 They're hollering at me. Wait a minute. Where's the car? (Talking to someone else;) 23 Okay. The car's at the water tower. 24 25 DAVID: Okay.

JIM: Are the kids --

1 DAVID: The kids are on their way, right? 2 JIM: The kids are on the way. It's a white 3 car at the water tower. 4 DAVID: Okay, it's a white car. They're on 5 their way. Okay. 6 JIM: Okay, they're -- the commander passed 7 on they're going to send a white car each time. DAVID: Okay, it's going to be a white car. 8 9 JIM: Right. 10 DAVID: With a radio in it, right? 11 JIM: With a radio in it. 12 DAVID: Okay. 13 JIM: Yes. DAVID: So, see, see, what I've always done 14 is I've never -- I never professed to be anything 15 except what the word of God says that I show. Now, 16 see, that way when I'm no longer around, them people 17 18 are going to be on their own. 19 JIM: Right. See? That way they are free, without 20 DAVID: any human hindrances to make their decisions with their 21 own mind and their own spirit. And that's, that's, 22 that's about as best as a man can do, isn't it? I 23 mean, truth is truth, and if we, if we don't walk in the truth that we have, then we have to deal with our 25 own selves, don't we?

1 JIM: Yeah, that pelvic bone? 2 DAVID: Yeah, you know, the two bones on like 3 your hips? 4 JIM: Yeah. 5 DAVID: Then it came out my back. 6 JIM: Right. 7 DAVID: My rear, you know. 8 JIM: Oh, man. Where else did you get hit? 9 Then I got hit over on the other Then there's a -- I got hit right here in my, my 10 11 wrist. Took a chunk out of my wrist and it's just +-I'm looking at it right now. That blood turns blacker 12 than black. 13 14 Did you get that to stop bleeding on JIM: 15 your wrist? 16 DAVID: Oh, yeah. Yeah, it stopped bleeding. And the wounds in the back just -- I don't know, they 17 just -- they ooze and then they stop and they ooze 18 again. It's just, you know --19 20 JIM: Yeah. Mmmm. Are you in a comfortable position? If there is one, huh? 21 22 DAVID: Something like that. It's hard to 23 explain. 24 JIM: Yeah. DAVID: You know, I kind of cried when I 25 looked out the window and saw all those ATF agents up

1 on the roof. 2 I appreciate you saying that. JIM: 3 DAVID: Well --4 I'll pass that on to the guys. it. 5 6 DAVID: It shouldn't have happened, Jim. 7 JIM: I know it. I know. I'll pass that on 8 to them. 9 DAVID: What can I say, you know? 10 Hey, I told Steve that, you know, I went by the hospital and that's kind of what held me 11 up, you know, some of that stuff, and I saw a lot of 12 those guys. And, you know, they're all doing good and 13 they're in good spirits and, you know, they're doing 14 fine and there's no animosity in their hearts or 15 anything. And I told them --16 17 DAVID: Jim, they, they don't know me. time, any time -- 'cause they know I didn't do it, but, 18 in a way, you know, it's my responsibility, you 19 understand. But the thing of it is is that in the 20 minds of men there's just two sides, their sides. And 21 those guys sit together and they drink coffee together 22 and they practice together, they put buddies together, 23 they may drink a beer together. You know, there's a 24 bond there. And they came down here doing their job 25 and they didn't have a clear picture, you know, and,

and they came out to do their job and, and they didn't, you know, they didn't know how to listen to me. 2 3 You know, I was trying to tell them to, you know, to get back away, you know. 4 5 JIM: Yeah. 6 There's children and women and DAVID: 7 children. But, you know, Jim, see, I've got an intuition. The prophets of old had visions, didn't 8 9 they? 10 JIM: Yeah. 11 DAVID: So, you know, you know, the boy -- your guys didn't have a chance. 12 13 JIM: David, that sounds like it's really 14 hurting you. 15 DAVID: We -- he knew that you were coming. I told Robert, I said look, I said they're coming. I 16 told Robert that. 17 18 JIM: Yeah. 19 They were nowhere in sight as of yet. And Robert sat right there looking at me, and I tried 20 to look him straight in the eye. You know, I thought 21 at least what he would do is tell the guys, you know, 22 hey, let's, let's slow up a bit. 23 24 JIM: Yeah. 25 DAVID: But, no, he went over and he had to go back and park his Blazer over there off of the

corner and all. You know, it didn't have to happen 2 this way. 3 JIM: Yeah. 4 DAVID: You know, you know, the reason why you've got arms is a show of arms, you know, to tell 5 the bad guys look --6 7 JIM: Hold it. Wait a minute. All right, just a minute. Hey, I'm sorry, David. They're asking 8 9 me did Sita leave yet. 10 DAVID: Has Sita left yet? Hey. Hey. Hello. I can't holler, you know. Has Sita left yet? 11 Well, get another car then. (Unidentified female voice 12 in background indiscernible.) 13 14 JIM: Can they just walk out? DAVID: They, they -- to, to walk all the way 15 16 down to the --JIM: Well, I mean, if she has a problem 17 getting a car or something, tell me and, you know, 18 maybe we can move up a little further, if that's --19 20 DAVID: Well, I --JIM: But I'd rather do it like this, if we 21 22 could. 23 DAVID: Yeah. That way for sure, you know --24 let's see, is the white truck out there? 25 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE VOICE: Is the white truck out there?

1	DAVID: Just any, just any car. Just any
2	car.
3	JIM: I guarantee they're safe conduct to
4	wherever you want to drive them.
5	DAVID: Who took the keys? Yeah. Okay, take
6	Misty's car. Okay, Jim.
