1 DAVID: -- was too old, right?

2 JIM: Right.

3 DAVID: Okay, God had promised, hadn't he?

4 JIM: Yeah.

5 DAVID: Well, who do you think was the one --

6 JIM: Hey, David, wait one second. I'm sorry  
7 to interrupt you. Has Sita already left?

8 DAVID: Sita left? Sita left? Go check and  
9 see, make sure Sita's left. We've got to get this  
10 underway. Well, anyway, we're checking on that now.

11 JIM: Okay.

12 DAVID: Anyway, Lois got pregnant and guess  
13 who got the blame, Jim?

14 JIM: Who?

15 DAVID: Me. Now, this shows you how human  
16 beings think, okay?

17 JIM: Um-hum.

18 DAVID: First of all, here I was 22, 23 years  
19 old, and here I am giving Lois and all these people  
20 studies about the power of God and the mystery of  
21 divinity. And Lois gets pregnant. Okay, now, what  
22 happened was that a lot of people rose up. There was  
23 originally branches. It was really Davidians, right?

24 JIM: Um-hum.

25 DAVID: And they accused me of going to bed  
with her and they accused her of going to bed with me.

1 | And this woman was very homely and 70 years old. You  
2 | know what I mean?

3 |           JIM: Yeah. Yeah, I do.

4 |           DAVID: And so what happened was is that I  
5 | said now, listen, there's a truth you've got to deal  
6 | with here. I says your accusations against me, let's  
7 | evaluate this. I says what if I did go to bed with  
8 | her? And she has conceived a child, and she doesn't  
9 | even have any seed. I says you better watch out your  
10 | accusations. Out of one side of your mouth you say you  
11 | believe in God, that God created a child in the womb of  
12 | Sarah. On the other side of your mouth you're saying  
13 | that if you're Lois your a prophet (Indiscernible) it  
14 | has to be from me that somebody's been doing naughty  
15 | stuff. Okay?

16 |           JIM: Um-hum.

17 |           DAVID: They're crazy, aren't they?

18 |           JIM: Um-hum.

19 |           DAVID: You know, a miracle would take place  
20 | if a 70-year-old woman could have a baby, wouldn't it?

21 |           JIM: Right. I, I guess so, yeah.

22 |           DAVID: See? Well, no one should have blamed  
23 | me. On the contrary, they should have prayed to God.  
24 | Okay. So what happened was all hell broke loose, and  
25 | hat's when George Roden got into the scene.

          JIM: Right.

1           DAVID: And he came in and he's waving around  
2 a .357 Reuger, a Nighthawk or a Magnum. And he was  
3 telling people he was going to blow my balls off and he  
4 was going to, you know, all this kind of stuff.

5           JIM: Hey, David?

6           DAVID: Yeah.

7           JIM: They got the kids and they're on the  
8 way. So, go ahead and get your next two.

9           DAVID: Okie doke.

10          JIM: And I think you said it was Scott and  
11 Chrissy?

12          DAVID: Okay. So, that's Scott and Chrissy  
13 now? Scott and Chrissy? Jim, could you do us a favor?

14          JIM: Sure. What do you need?

15          DAVID: Could you get our line open again to  
16 where we could call the radio station again?

17          JIM: I, I can see, David.

18          DAVID: They shut us off.

19          JIM: Yeah. I'll tell you, I'll be straight  
20 up with you. I, I can see, but I don't hold that much  
21 hope because there's so much, you know, the commanders  
22 have to work on it. I'll tell you, there's a billion  
23 reporters out here. I mean, I think they've got every  
24 phone line tied up plus, a lot of times, you know --

25          DAVID: What's happened is they just, they  
just disconnected our line to where we can only call

1 | you.

2 |           JIM: Yeah. Okay.

3 |           DAVID: So, you know --

4 |           JIM: Well, I'll see what I can do. I'll  
5 | give you an honest word. I'll see what I can do, but -

6 | -

7 |           DAVID: Are they still going to play that  
8 | message?

9 |           JIM: What message? Oh, yeah, play the  
10 | message on the radio station?

11 |           DAVID: Yeah.

12 |           JIM: Yeah. Okay, let me, let me get that  
13 | taken care of.

14 |           DAVID: Okay.

15 |           JIM: Is Phil out there (Indiscernible)? If  
16 | I need him, I'll send him in. Yeah, okay. (Talking to  
17 | someone else.) The problem with the telephone, David,  
18 | is like this is really a normal procedure, you know, to  
19 | keep a -- keep the lifeline going, you know, between  
20 | you and me.

21 |           DAVID: Yeah, but our other lines have been  
22 | cut off.

23 |           JIM: Oh, okay. Yeah, I understand. I  
24 | understand. Yeah. Yeah. Well, let me see if --  
25 | David.

          DAVID: Yeah?



1 JIM: Hold on just a second.

2 DAVID: Where's my -- where's little Koresh  
3 at?

4 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: You've got all  
5 four kids in that house?

6 JIM: No, I've got two kids.

7 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: -- transition.  
8 (Unidentified voices in background not discernible.)

9 JIM: Hey, David.

10 DAVID: Huh?

11 JIM: I need you to help me out on this.

12 DAVID: Go ahead.

13 JIM: Okay. The commanders got, got the two  
14 kids and they want to change this room I'm in. You  
15 know, I've got to move because I'm in this little bitty  
16 room and I don't have any room, and I've got all these  
17 people in here. And so what they wanted me to do is  
18 move across the way. I'm out at the airport. You know  
19 where the airport is?

20 DAVID: Right, yeah.

21 JIM: And they want me to move across to this  
22 other building where there's more room, you know, and  
23 it'll be quiet.

24 DAVID: What's your number?

25 JIM: They'll do -- I'll call you with it and  
tell you, you know, no problem. But what I'd like to

1 do before we take a break is just to, you know, get  
2 those other two kids ready and, you know, send another  
3 car and get that. And then maybe we could take a  
4 little break, and then once I get to the new place,  
5 I'll get back with you.

6 DAVID: Okay. Are they going to -- well,  
7 like you say, then when the next car comes, can they,  
8 can they bring us in new lines so we don't get cut off  
9 as much?

10 JIM: Yeah, I'm working on that. I'm working  
11 on that. Yeah, I want to work on it. I'll see what I  
12 can do for you.

13 DAVID: Okay. Now, now, now, now, remember,  
14 I gave \$1,000 to those guys, and I want you to get that  
15 \$1,000.

16 JIM: Oh, hey, don't worry about it.

17 DAVID: Jim, you've got to -- I'm serious.

18 JIM: Hey, let me give -- you got a pencil?  
19 I'm going to give you this new phone number.

20 DAVID: Okay. Hey, Rach, Rachel, could you  
21 take a, take a note pad and a piece of paper? I've got  
22 a number for you? Where's the pencil?

23 JIM: (Unidentified male voice in background  
24 not discernible.) Really?

25 DAVID: Where's the pad with -- do you see  
it?

1 JIM: Can we work that, we can help?

2 (Talking to someone else.)

3 DAVID: Did you get the -- okay, here you  
4 are, take -- put it on that there -- put it on that  
5 pad. (Talking to someone else.) What is it now, Jim?

6 JIM: It's 799 --

7 DAVID: Seven nine nine --

8 JIM: -- 0545.

9 DAVID: -- oh five four five.

10 JIM: Okay?

11 DAVID: Seven nine nine --

12 JIM: Oh five four five.

13 DAVID: -- oh five four five.

14 JIM: Now, I'll call you first, okay? And  
15 so -- until we know it's clear.

16 DAVID: Okay. All right.

17 JIM: We're going to send the other car to  
18 the water tower.

19 DAVID: Okay.

20 JIM: Okay, so, can you get Scott and  
21 Chrissy?

22 DAVID: Yeah.

23 JIM: 'Cause what I don't want to happen is  
24 they're switching my room and we're in the middle of --  
25 and the kids, you know, 'cause I've got to kind of, you  
know, get off for a few minutes.

1 DAVID: Okay, will do.

2 JIM: So tell --

3 DAVID: Call me up as soon as the car gets  
4 there.

5 JIM: Yeah, but let's hang on until we get  
6 these other two kids in the car, and then we'll, then  
7 we'll get off, okay? 'Cause -- yeah. You've got --  
8 Who have you got there, Sonja?

9 DAVID: Probably. They're not back yet.

10 JIM: Oh, Sita's not back?

11 DAVID: No.

12 JIM: Okay. All right, let, let, let me, let  
13 me call you in a minute.

14 DAVID: Okay.

15 JIM: I need to, I need to work this out with  
16 the commanders 'cause I, I want to, you know, I want  
17 (Indiscernible) kids in the driveway and you and me  
18 ought to talk, you know.

19 DAVID: Kids in the driveway?

20 JIM: I mean I don't want that to happen.  
21 You know what I'm saying? I don't want Sita walking  
22 down the driveway and we're not on the phone.

23 DAVID: Oh, okay.

24 JIM: You know what I mean.

25 DAVID: Okay.

JIM: And we have the two children. They're

1 | on their way here safely, okay?

2 |         DAVID: Okay.

3 |         JIM: And I'll just -- we'll just break off  
4 | for a few minutes --

5 |         DAVID: Okay.

6 |         JIM: -- then I'll get back with you.

7 |         DAVID: Okay. Bye, Jim.

8 |         JIM: Okay, Buddy, I'll see you.

10 |         JIM: Do we have transportation over there?  
11 | Do we have transportation to -- no, we're going to get  
12 | them over two kids out first, aren't we?

13 |         DAVID: Good afternoon. May I help you?  
14 | Hello?

15 |                         \* \* \* \*

16 |         UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Hello?

17 |         JIM: Hello, Yvette?

18 |         UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Huh?

19 |         JIM: This is Jim.

20 |         UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Okay, wait one  
21 | moment. Do you want to speak to David?

22 |         JIM: Yeah, please.

23 |         UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Okay.

24 |         DAVID: Okay.

25 |         JIM: How you doing, Buddy?

       DAVID: It's a miracle.

1 JIM: Have you got those other kids ready?

2 DAVID: Are the kids ready? Chrissy and  
3 who's next? Chrissy and Scott.

4 JIM: Chrissy and Scott, yeah.

5 DAVID: Got to -- were you calling from the  
6 new number?

7 JIM: No, not yet. I'm going to get -- move  
8 over there in a few minutes. I wanted to get this done  
9 first.

10 DAVID: Are they sending -- oh. Are they  
11 playing the message on the radio? (Unidentified male  
12 voice in background not discernible.)

13 JIM: He's talking to one of his buds, asked  
14 him if they played the message on the radio.  
15 (Unidentified male voice in background not  
16 discernible.) Yeah, yeah. Could you tell me what time  
17 they're going to do the movement, so I can tell him --  
18 (Unidentified male voice in background not  
19 discernible.) Okay.

20 DAVID: Who? What? My grandmother? Turn it  
21 on.

22 JIM: He thinks his grandmother is on the  
23 radio or the TV or something.

24 UNIDENTIFIED MALE VOICE: Yeah.

25 DAVID: Did you hear that, Jim?

JIM: No, I didn't, David.

1 DAVID: My grandmother is on an interview.

2 JIM: Where?

3 DAVID: I'm trying to get the details. I was  
4 always told by my family that, that I'm kind of  
5 strange.

6 JIM: Where's your grandmother live?

7 DAVID: She lives down in Chandler.

8 JIM: Yeah.

9 DAVID: Chandler's close to Tyler.

10 JIM: Yeah, yeah, I know where it is. That's  
11 pretty country over there.

12 DAVID: Oh, yeah. I love that country. I  
13 used to fish on Lake Tyler --

14 JIM: Oh, did you? Yeah. They've got a  
15 little train runs down that way.

16 DAVID: How do you spell your last name  
17 again, Jim?

18 JIM: C-A-V -- C-A-V --

19 DAVID: All right, just a second. C --

20 JIM: -- A-V --

21 DAVID: Wait a minute. The pen just died on  
22 me. Looks like a brand-new one, too.

23 JIM: Hmmmm.

24 DAVID: Can you all give me another pen,  
25 please? Sherry, try to get this to write. I need --  
Sherry? Sherry's not behind me, is she? Oh, okay

1 she's -- yeah, yeah. C-A-V? C-A-V?  
2 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: I'll connect it  
3 off.  
4 JIM: David?  
5 DAVID: Yeah.  
6 JIM: Did you get your pencil?  
7 DAVID: Yeah. C-A --  
8 JIM: C-A-V-A-N-A-U-G-H.  
9 DAVID: A-N --  
10 JIM: A-U -- C-A-V-A-N-A-U-G-H.  
11 DAVID: -- A-U-G-H. Okie doke.  
12 JIM: Is she getting the kids ready?  
13 DAVID: Yeah. Are those other kids there  
14 yet?  
15 (Pause)  
16 JIM: David?  
17 DAVID: Yeah.  
18 JIM: Are you okay, Buddy?  
19 DAVID: Yeah, I'm all right.  
20 JIM: I just heard you groan a little bit.  
21 Are the kids -- I don't hear the kids.  
22 DAVID: You don't hear the what?  
23 JIM: I don't hear the kids.  
24 DAVID: Oh, well, you all kids want to make  
25 some noise?  
JIM: (Laughing) That's usually not a



1 | problem, kids making noise.

2 |           DAVID: Oh, there's babies all in here,  
3 | hollering. I keep looking at them the last, last time.

4 |           JIM: Yeah. You'll see them again.

5 |           DAVID: Oh, I know. I promise.

6 |           JIM: Who's helping them, Sita or Sonja or  
7 | what?

8 |           DAVID: Is Sita -- yeah, they're back.

9 |           JIM: Is Sita there?

10 |           DAVID: Where's Sita?

11 |           UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: --

12 |           DAVID: She can come here.

13 |           JIM: Yeah, let me talk to her a minute.

14 |           DAVID: All right.

15 |           Sita: Jim?

16 |           JIM: Hi, Sita.

17 |           Sita: Yes?

18 |           JIM: That went smooth, okay?

19 |           Sita: Oh, yes, fine. I just forgot one  
20 | thing to give to the guys.

21 |           JIM: Okay.

22 |           Sita: But I'll give them the next round.

23 |           JIM: That's great, that's great. Now, are,  
24 | are these next two ready 'cause I've got the car there  
25 | waiting, so I wanted to kind of get them out.

          Sita: Okay. Is there ladies watching the

1 baby?

2 JIM: Yes. Oh, yes, absolutely. I've got  
3 two ladies here.

4 Sita: So you (Indiscernible) I, I gave you  
5 the milk and the carob. I forgot to get the honey.

6 JIM: Yeah. Give me the info on these next  
7 two. Is it -- is this Scott and Chrissy Mabb?

8 Sita: Yes, Scott and Chrissy Mabb.

9 JIM: And how old are they?

10 Sita: How old are you? Eleven --

11 JIM: Okay.

12 Sita: -- and seven.

13 JIM: Okay.

14 Sita: Scott is 11.

15 JIM: Okay.

16 Sita: And Chrissy is seven.

17 JIM: Okay. All right, good. Why, why don't  
18 you go ahead and get their coats and let them kiss and  
19 hug there and say goodbye and take them out because the  
20 car is at the water tower?

21 Sita: Okay.

22 JIM: Okay? And listen.

23 Sita: Yeah?

24 JIM: And then -- I told David I'm going to  
25 have to get off the phone for a few minutes, but I'll  
be back and, you know, I'll let you talk to them and

1 all.

2 Sita: Okay. You want to talk to David  
3 before you go out?

4 JIM: Yeah, let me have David. You walk them  
5 out right now, okay?

6 Sita: Okay.

7 JIM: 'Cause the car's waiting and I need to  
8 get the word.

9 Sita: Okay.

10 JIM: Okay, Sita. Thanks.

11 DAVID: Hello.

12 JIM: Hey, Buddy, she, she does a good job.

13 DAVID: Oh, so they're going to open our  
14 telephone lines up now?

15 JIM: No, I haven't got the word on that.

16 DAVID: Oh, this is what they were saying on  
17 the radio, that --

18 JIM: Oh, really?

19 DAVID: Yeah.

20 JIM: Listen, this Scott, he's 11 years old?

21 DAVID: Yeah.

22 JIM: Yeah. He must be a big boy.

23 DAVID: He's, he's kind of small. He's thin.

24 Hey, guy, don't worry about it, okay?

25 JIM: Yeah, we'll take care of him. Tell him  
--

1           DAVID: Hey, you can take your motorcycle,  
2 too. You be sure and tell them that one of the  
3 motorcycles here is yours, okay? All right.

4           JIM: We move before we -- okay.

5           DAVID: I'll be sure and tell him  
6 that -- when this is all over that the motorcycle's  
7 yours, all right? Okay. All right. Love you. Bye.  
8 Come here and give me a kiss. Love you. Remember all  
9 I taught you, okay? And you're going to be a good girl  
10 now, right? -- yeah, I'm going to, I'm going to lick  
11 it.

12           DAVID: Okay. All right. Now, Jim --

13           JIM: Yeah.

14           DAVID: -- make sure these guys are bringing  
15 the kids to you.

16           JIM: Yeah.

17           DAVID: So you make sure you -- when you,  
18 when you get this that I'm giving to you, you know, and  
19 you open this up, I want you to tell me exactly what's  
20 in it, all right?

21           JIM: You've got it, I will.

22           DAVID: Okay. All right. Have the kids  
23 gotten there yet?

24           JIM: No, uh-uh. They sure haven't.

25           DAVID: They haven't gotten there yet. She's  
getting them ready.

1 JIM: Hey, David, I really want to thank you.  
2 I appreciate this.

3 DAVID: Oh, well, I appreciate it.

4 JIM: You know --

5 DAVID: I've always had faith in mankind, you  
6 know, that you don't have to always be so beastly.

7 JIM: Well --

8 DAVID: You know?

9 JIM: -- you're, you're a wise man.

10 DAVID: I figured, I figured you all would  
11 turn back when I told you there was women and children  
12 here, but, you know --

13 JIM: Are they coming? Are they -- got their  
14 coats on?

15 DAVID: Yeah, they're getting all ready.

16 JIM: Getting all ready? Here, give me Sita  
17 again. Is she there?

18 DAVID: Yeah, she's here.

19 JIM: Okay, let me talk to her.

20 Sita: Hello?

21 JIM: Sita?

22 Sita: Yes.

23 JIM: Okay, are they ready?

24 Sita: Yes.

25 JIM: Okay, you going out now?

Sita: Are they playing the --

1 JIM: We already played it.

2 Sita: We didn't hear it.

3 JIM: Oh. Well, we played it before. I'll  
4 play it again. I mean, I will.

5 Sita: Thanks a lot.

6 JIM: Okay. Just take them out to the car,  
7 okay?

8 Sita: Okay.

9 JIM: Okay.

10 (Pause)

11 JIM TO UNIDENTIFIED PERSON: Losing them.  
12 What's happened? They're not there. Have you got  
13 them? Dead. Okay. Okay.

14 JIM: David? David?

15 JIM TO UNIDENTIFIED PERSON: I've lost him.

16 \* \* \* \*

17 STEVE: Hello.

18 JIM: Hey, Steve?

19 STEVE: Yes.

20 JIM: This is Jim.

21 STEVE: Hi, Jim.

22 JIM: Hey, that phone just went --

23 STEVE: Okay.

24 JIM: -- off on me.

25 STEVE TO UNIDENTIFIED PERSON: Where are they  
at now? So, have they been -- the, the other group has

1 | been picked up, right, the two?

2 |           JIM TO UNIDENTIFIED PERSON: Have they picked  
3 | them up?

4 |           UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: The first two,  
5 | yes.

6 |           JIM: Yeah, the first two we got.

7 |           STEVE: Okay.

8 |           JIM: But Sita was coming out right now with  
9 | --

10 |           STEVE: Yeah. I guess they're waiting to  
11 | hear that announcement on the radio.

12 |           JIM: Oh. We played it, though, a while --  
13 | we'll play it again.

14 |           STEVE: Okay.

15 |           JIM: I mean I'll play it twice for you.  
16 | Just I've got the car sitting there and --

17 |           STEVE: Okay.

18 |           JIM: -- I wanted to get them, you know.

19 |           STEVE TO UNIDENTIFIED PERSON: He says he'd  
20 | like to get them. He's going to play it twice for us.

21 |           JIM: Steve?

22 |           STEVE: Yeah.

23 |           JIM: Did Sita take them out?

24 |           STEVE: Not yet. She's standing right here.

25 |           JIM: Oh, okay.

          STEVE: She's right here. They're ready to

1 go.

2 JIM: Ready to go. The car is waiting.

3 STEVE: Okay.

4 JIM: So just have her go. Just go on out.

5 STEVE: There are four to six guys  
6 camouflaged right now down at the barn. Honestly, no  
7 joke.

8 JIM: Four to six guys at the barn?

9 STEVE: Yes.

10 JIM: I don't know where that is. Is that  
11 the back barn?

12 STEVE: Yes, yes. It's kind of a block, a  
13 cement block building.

14 JIM: Okay.

15 STEVE: They're on the property.

16 JIM: Oh, on the property. Okay.

17 STEVE: They're on the property.

18 JIM: Okay. Let me, let me check on this,  
19 okay?

20 STEVE: All right. Okay.

21 JIM: Hold on one second.

22 STEVE: All right.

23 JIM TO UNIDENTIFIED PERSON: Hey, Steve,  
24 Steve said that there's four guys at the barn. Check  
25 on that.

JIM: Okay, we're checking.



1 STEVE: All right.

2 JIM: The barn --

3 STEVE: Just hold on one minute.

4 JIM: Okay. Hey, Steve.

5 STEVE: On the other side of the fence then,  
6 there's two or three guys crouched.

7 JIM: Oh, which fence now are we talking  
8 about?

9 STEVE: Right in the back.

10 JIM: Well, I'll check on it,  
11 but --

12 STEVE: Okay. But right on the property,  
13 sure, you know, I mean --

14 JIM: I'll check on it, but, look, Sita has  
15 guaranteed safe conduct.

16 STEVE: Right, I realize that. But, you  
17 know, they, they always get nervous when, you know -- I  
18 don't understand why those guys are doing that. We  
19 want to keep right on moving with this.

20 JIM: Right. Well, go ahead and send Sita  
21 out. The car is waiting. In the meantime, I'll, I'll  
22 follow up on that. But, you know, if it's way out in  
23 the back, you know, I'll check on it.

24 STEVE: Okay.

25 JIM: And, you know, we'll get it fixed. But  
go ahead and send her out. Oh, hey, Steve. Steve.

1 Steve. Are they coming?

2 STEVE: Yeah, they're coming.

3 JIM: Okay. I just found out --

4 STEVE: Yeah.

5 JIM: -- you're right. There were people  
6 there. They were police. I just found out, we just  
7 gave them the word to move back.

8 STEVE: Okay, thank you.

9 JIM: I'm sorry that happened.

10 STEVE: Okay, I believe that.

11 JIM: They were, were not supposed to be  
12 there.

13 STEVE: Thank you much.

14 JIM: It was a, you know, -- there was a lot  
15 of people involved and, you know, communications --

16 STEVE: Right.

17 JIM: But we got the word for them to move  
18 back and -- yeah, we're having a shift change.

19 STEVE: Pardon?

20 JIM: We're having a shift change.

21 STEVE: I see.

22 JIM: And, you know, we've got a lot of  
23 people here and everybody's moving around, you know,  
24 and --

25 STEVE: Right.

JIM: -- I told David we're -- they're

1 | kicking us out of this building we're in. We've got to  
2 | go across the alleyway here to another place.

3 |           STEVE: Oh, no. Really?

4 |           JIM: It's no problem. It's just more room,  
5 | you know?

6 |           STEVE: Right.

7 |           JIM: And then we're having a shift change  
8 | and there's people moving all around. You know what I  
9 | mean. So, I'm sorry it happened, but --

10 |           STEVE: Right.

11 |           JIM: -- we moved them back. Did Sita, did  
12 | Sita leave?

13 |           STEVE: Just a minute, let me see 'cause she  
14 | went down.

15 |           JIM: Okay.

16 |           STEVE: Yes, she did leave.

17 |           JIM: She did leave? Okay.

18 |           STEVE: Yeah, she left from up -- she left  
19 | from where I'm at here.

20 |           JIM: Okay. All right. Here's what we're  
21 | going to do. We're going to --

22 |           STEVE: He says, he doesn't -- he says, I  
23 | don't want to rush these kids out of here.

24 |           JIM: Oh, no, no. No, no. Here's what we're  
25 | going to do. I'm going to wait till they make the  
hook-up.

1 STEVE: Okay.

2 JIM: Okay? And then I'm going to have to --  
3 I'm going to tell you we got them safe, and then I'm  
4 going to have to get off 'cause they're switching my  
5 office. Okay?

6 STEVE: Okay. How long will that be then  
7 (Indiscernible) return?

8 JIM: You know, half hour, 45 minutes.

9 STEVE: Okay.

10 JIM: And, and just take a break and, you  
11 know, maybe you and David can get some time and talk  
12 and --

13 STEVE: Yeah, he said, you know, he was  
14 giving up, he said, the most precious thing in life.

15 JIM: I know.

16 STEVE: Yeah, these women. They are, the  
17 women are giving up, you know, their most, you know, it  
18 came from their body.

19 JIM: I understand and --

20 STEVE: I know you do. Are you a father,  
21 too?

22 JIM: Yes, I have two children.

23 STEVE: Oh, that's good. Yeah, you would  
24 understand. It's hard for him to let them go.

25 JIM: Well, he's not giving them up. I mean,  
he --

1 STEVE: Well, you know what I mean, though,  
2 just even for a, you know --

3 JIM: A little while, yeah.

4 STEVE: Exactly. I know, but you know how  
5 mothers are.

6 JIM: You, guys visit and talk and --

7 STEVE: Exactly, right.

8 JIM: -- while we take a break, you know.  
9 I'm hoping maybe David's ministry will go on and I want  
10 you guys to talk about that and us resolving this  
11 thing.

12 STEVE: Right.

13 JIM: You know, we can do it --

14 STEVE: Right.

15 JIM: -- and he, and he needs -- Steve, I'm  
16 going to tell you something -- where you can help me --  
17 he needs some medical attention. I'm really worried  
18 about him.

19 STEVE: Oh, I've been telling him that, but  
20 he keeps on saying he's fine.

21 JIM: Yeah. Well, you, you talk to him for  
22 me and --

23 STEVE: Okay.

24 JIM: -- and just we're concerned. I mean,  
25 an infection or something, you know.

STEVE: Right.

1 JIM: We're just concerned about him. I  
2 mean, you know --

3 STEVE: Yeah, I know. I was after him even  
4 an hour ago.

5 JIM: Yeah, we, we, we, we've got enough  
6 tragedy. We don't want any more.

7 STEVE: Right.

8 JIM: And, you know, you think about it and  
9 talk with him.

10 STEVE: Okay.

11 JIM: We'll try to get him --

12 STEVE: All right. You want to call me back  
13 then?

14 JIM: I just wanted to give you the word we  
15 had the children.

16 STEVE: Okay, so I'll hang on.

17 JIM: Just hang on for just a second.

18 STEVE: All right.

19 JIM: I'm going to check and see if they've  
20 got them.

21 STEVE: Right. Okay.

22 JIM: Hold on one second -- all right,

4 JIM: You've got a call?

6 JIM: What is it, a reporter or something?

7 STEVE: Somebody that I guess we knew from  
8 quite a while ago, you know, one that was here. You  
9 know, are you okay and all that?

18 going to go talk to him.

21 right off, okay? You know what I mean?

22 STEVE: Yeah.

23 JIM: I just want to hook them up and then,  
24 and then we'll get off for a while.

25 STEVE: Just a minute.

JIM: Yeah, Sita, Sita's out there.

1 (Unidentified male voice in background not  
2 discernible.)

3 JIM TO UNIDENTIFIED PERSON: Do we, do we  
4 have them?

5 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: No. They haven't  
6 left the compound?

7 JIM TO UNIDENTIFIED PERSON: They haven't?

8 DAVID: Okay, they're -- Jim?

9 JIM: Hey, David.

10 DAVID: Okay.

11 JIM: Where's Sita?

12 DAVID: I'm listening to this Dobbs guy try  
13 to explain away everything.

14 JIM: Where's Sita at?

15 DAVID TO UNIDENTIFIED PERSON: Where's Sita,  
16 is she downstairs now?

17 JIM: Okay, they're getting in their --

18 DAVID: They're in the car?

19 JIM: Yeah, Sita's getting in her car, I  
20 think.

21 DAVID: Okay.

22 JIM: Yeah, okay. That's what Steve said.  
23 Okay.

24 DAVID: Well, you -- the guys down at the  
25 tower will probably see them. Where I'm at, I can't  
see them.



1 JIM: Yeah, okay. Okay. And the car's  
2 waiting on them. Listen, as soon as we hook them up,  
3 okay, which is going to be in just a few -- two  
4 minutes, I've got to get off because they're switching  
5 my office. Okay?

6 DAVID: All right.

7 JIM: And I'll call you back. We're having a  
8 big shift change. There's all kinds of police, you  
9 know, that worked all night and agents that are moving  
10 around, ambulances, you know. You know, everybody's  
11 got to go to bed, you know.

12 DAVID: Yeah.

13 JIM: You can appreciate that.

14 DAVID: Oh, yeah.

4 I've got them, so that -- yeah (Indiscernible) says --  
5 what? They didn't come out yet.

6 DAVID TO UNIDENTIFIED PERSON: Where are they  
7 at? Where are the kids at? Have they left yet?

8 JIM: Okay. Yeah. David?

9 DAVID: Yeah.

10 JIM: I think they're out front. Tell  
11 somebody to tell them to come on.

12 DAVID TO UNIDENTIFIED PERSON: Tell them to  
13 go ahead and go down. (Unidentified female voice in  
14 background not discernible.)

15 JIM: Man, you're hurting, huh?

16 DAVID: Yeah, Jim, it, it hurts.

17 JIM: Yeah.

18 DAVID: I won't lie to you.

19 JIM: Well, think about -- I want you to  
20 think about me getting you some medical attention. I  
21 want you to think about it.

22 DAVID: I'm telling you, you've got all these  
23 guys out there that are just telling everybody that I'm  
24 a cult leader.

25 JIM: Well, that wasn't us. You know --

DAVID: As long as I'm alive, I'm a cult

1 leader.

2 JIM: Yeah.

3 DAVID: Now, when I'm gone, see, then I'll be  
4 removed out of the way and people will be free to think  
5 their own thoughts.

6 JIM: Well, I don't want you to be gone. I,  
7 I want to -- I'd like to see your ministry carry on and  
8 I'd like --

9 DAVID: My ministry -- I've been in it ever  
10 since 1985 full force. One out of a thousand people,  
11 okay?

12 JIM: Yeah.

13 DAVID: One out of a thousand are interested  
14 in the Bible enough to learn --

15 JIM: David, I'm sorry. They're coming,  
16 Sita's coming right now.

17 DAVID: Okay.

18 JIM: Okay? I want to give you the word in  
19 just a minute. I just want you to think about, think  
20 about some medical attention. Talk to Steve. He, he's  
21 your right-hand man.

22 DAVID: I've thought about it.

23 JIM: He's your right-hand man.

24 DAVID: Well --

20           JIM: You know, only a weak man, you know,  
21 couldn't change his --

22           DAVID: The seven seals.

23           JIM: There's so much inside you. I mean,  
24 you can do it.

25           DAVID: The seven seals, Jim.

          JIM: Yeah, I know, David.

1           DAVID: Okay.

2           JIM: I just, I just don't want you to suffer  
3 any more.

4           DAVID: Well, the children are there, right?

5           JIM: Okay, they're almost together, the  
6 agent said. Just a minute.

18 |           DAVID: Yeah, it's my arm -- thanks. Go  
19 | ahead.

20 |           JIM: You hear?

21 |           DAVID: Yeah.

22 |           JIM: We've got the kids, okay? Everything's  
23 | great. We're going to take a break. It'll be good for  
24 | you, be good for everyone.

25 |           DAVID: Yeah, I need to rest up, get my  
energy going.



1 JIM: Hey, I love you, Buddy. Now hang in  
2 there.

3 DAVID: Okie doke. Catch you later, Jim.

4 JIM: All right, bye.

5 DAVID: Bye.

4 JIM: Play the message again. Absolutely.  
5 We're going to get that done right now.

6 KATHY: Okay.

7 JIM: What -- how, how many more kids are  
8 there?

9 KATHY: Oh, there's a lot.

10 JIM: Yeah? Ten, twelve, fourteen?

11 KATHY: I, I, I don't even keep track any  
12 more. I don't know how many have left, I don't know,  
13 you know --

14 JIM: Yeah, okay. Okay. Well, I'm kind of  
15 concerned about David. I know he was bleeding real bad  
16 and I'm just real worried about him.

17 KATHY: Yeah, he's pretty bad.

18 JIM: Yeah. I'm real worried about that. I  
19 don't want him to get an infection or something. And,  
20 you know, I'd like to get him some medical help, but --  
21 okay, are you -- is -- did Sita bring these children  
22 out?

23 KATHY: Yes.

24 JIM: Okay. Well, that seems to be working  
25 well.

KATHY: Yes. Just remember she's not a kid,

1 | even though she looks like one.

2 |           JIM: Who?

3 |           KATHY: Sita.

4 |           JIM: Sita. No, I, I understand. The agents  
5 | have already seen her, you know --

6 |           KATHY: Yeah.

7 |           JIM: -- a bunch of times and --

8 |           KATHY: Yeah.

9 |           JIM: -- she's doing a great job and you guys  
10 | are super. This was great. So just keep it up and  
11 | keep, keep positive. Everything's going to work out.

12 |           KATHY: Okay.

13 |           JIM: And you have my word on it now. Just  
14 | work with us, okay?

15 |           KATHY: Okay.

16 |           JIM: All right. Who else is around there?  
17 | Is David there?

18 |           KATHY: Yes, he's right here. He's laying  
19 | down.

20 |           JIM: Okay.

21 |           KATHY: You want to talk to him?

22 |           JIM: Well, if, if he wants a break, I'll  
23 | just hang on with you for a minute if --

24 |           KATHY: Okay. Yeah, he wants to get some  
25 | rest.

          JIM: Okay. Is there anything you need to

1 ask me?

2 KATHY: No. I just, I just want to make sure  
3 they get to their dad, basically, you know.

4 JIM: What's his name, can you tell me?

5 KATHY: William Mabb.

6 JIM: Okay.

7 KATHY: And, you know, he, he has already,  
8 you know, wanted them in the past, so --

9 JIM: Yeah.

10 KATHY: -- he -- oh, what's --

11 JIM: Kathy?

12 KATHY: Yeah.

13 JIM: You need to turn on Radio 1080, KRLB.

14 We're going to play the message.

15 KATHY: Okay.

16 JIM: And I don't want you to miss it.

17 KATHY: Okay. It's on right over here. He's  
18 going to play the message. Okay.

19 JIM: What, what, what can I tell the kids  
20 about when you're going to see them again? They're  
21 going to -- starting to be, you know, wanting to see  
22 you.

23 KATHY: Tell me them soon. Tell them soon,  
24 I'll see them soon.

25 JIM: Okay. All right. 'Cause, you know,  
they're going to be asking for you and stuff, you know.

1 KATHY: Yeah, especially Brian when he comes  
2 out.

3 JIM: Okay. So, you know, I don't --

4 KATHY: He's probably going to cry.

5 JIM: Yeah. Well --

6 KATHY: But tell him I'll see him soon.

7 JIM: Okay.

8 KATHY: Mommy will come and get him soon.

9 JIM: Okay. Okay.

10 KATHY: I know their dad'll take care of  
11 them.

12 JIM: Yeah. Well, he's pretty far away,  
13 though, isn't he?

14 KATHY: Well, you know, legal battles, you  
15 know, could ensue, but he, he would end up getting them  
16 anyway. So I'd rather they just go to him.

17 JIM: Well, okay. We're concerned, you know,  
18 for their safety and, you know, I'm sure it'll be a  
19 little traumatic for them to go with their dad if  
20 they've been with you. How long have they been with  
21 you? Their whole life, I guess?

22 KATHY: Yeah.

23 JIM: Yeah. Has he ever had them?

24 KATHY: Well, for a vacation, you know.

25 JIM: Yeah. But that's kind of short, isn't  
it?

1 KATHY: Well, yeah.

2 JIM: Does he -- has he got a good job up  
3 there?

4 KATHY: He's in the service.

5 JIM: Yeah, okay. The Air Force probably.

6 KATHY: Yeah.

7 JIM: That's what's in South Dakota.

8 KATHY: Right. Rapid City.

9 JIM: Rapid City. A little cold up there.

10 KATHY: Yeah.

11 JIM: Does he have any other family,  
12 children, up there?

13 KATHY: Yes, he does.

14 JIM: Okay. All right. Well, we'll, we'll  
15 sure try to reach him.

16 KATHY: Yeah, he's, he's, he's very well  
17 capable of taking care of them.

18 JIM: Okay.

19 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: As soon as you're  
20 done, I've got a call.

21 KATHY: Call who? I'm talking to Jim.

22 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Are you?

23 KATHY: Steve needs to talk to you.

24 JIM: Okay.

25 KATHY: Okay.

JIM: Thanks for your help.



1 KATHY: Okay. You take care of them and get  
2 them to Bill and, and he'll take care of them.

3 JIM: Okay.

4 KATHY: I know he will.

5 JIM: You hang in there now.

6 KATHY: Oh, yeah.

7 JIM: We're all going to get out of this  
8 and --

9 KATHY: Okay.

10 JIM: -- come through this okay. You got it?

11 KATHY: Okay. You just, you just keep doing  
12 your good job.

13 JIM: All right. Hang in there.

14 KATHY: Thank you.

15 JIM: Okay, Kathy.

16 KATHY: Take care.

17 JIM: All right.

18 STEVE: Hello, Jim.

19 JIM: Hey, Steve, how you doing?

20 STEVE: Not good because I was downstairs --  
21 Hello?

22 JIM: Hello. Hey.

23 STEVE: He just -- his knee hit the, the --  
24 look out, look out there. Okay. Yeah, we're not too  
25 happy because Wayne called me into -- pardon? (To  
someone else.) David is really getting upset because

1 | we were downstairs, the telephone rang, his parents are  
2 | on the phone. They were saying a few words to him and  
3 | he was just telling them to be cool, that everything  
4 | was being worked out, and the phone went dead.

5 |           JIM: Oh.

6 |           STEVE: They couldn't call in. Nobody can  
7 | and you can't call out. David said he's going to stop  
8 | the children even.

9 |           JIM: Well, I don't want him to do that.

10 |           STEVE: I mean, there, there's no sense in  
11 | doing that with the phone. Nothing's being said. He's  
12 | talking to them about relaxing and --

13 |           JIM: Sure.

14 |           STEVE: -- trying to keep these people, you  
15 | know, you know, they're all upset and they don't know  
16 | what's going on.

17 |           JIM: Sure, I understand.

18 |           STEVE: They want to hear the voices and  
19 | we're trying to just say just look, like, you know,  
20 | it's being worked out, but, you know, they like to hear  
21 | it from us, of course.

22 |           JIM: Yeah. I understand.

23 |           STEVE: Can, can you have them open up a line  
24 | again? I mean, in fact, you know, it's -- is it a big  
25 | deal or what?

          JIM: Well --

1           STEVE: David's saying tell them to open up a  
2 line.

3           JIM: Okay. I'll, I'll have to pass it up to  
4 the commanders, okay? I've got to be straight up with  
5 you. It's going to be very difficult.

6           STEVE: Okay. Well, I'm, I'm going to put  
7 the phone down and you can call me back. Or, if I  
8 don't hear from you in a while, I'll call you back.

9           JIM: Okay.

10          STEVE: Go to them, talk to them, because, I  
11 mean, everything yesterday, I mean, we appreciated that  
12 you allowed us to talk with some of these stations  
13 about what we believe in.

14          JIM: Right.

15          STEVE: Here's David.

16          JIM: Okay.

17          DAVID: Yeah, Jim --

18          JIM: David, how you doing?

19          DAVID: Now, listen to me.

20          JIM: Okay.

21          DAVID: You guys are telling the public of  
22 this country that you don't want any blood. All right,  
23 now, I made a deal with you. You tell these boys they  
24 better get our lines back operatable, okay?

25          JIM: Um-hum.

          DAVID: Or they're going to go to bed every

1 | night with the knowledge that they're the one that  
2 | killed these little children.

3 |           JIM: Okay, David.

4 |           DAVID: No playing around any more, okay?

5 |           JIM: I know. Listen, just hang --

6 |           DAVID: No, you listen. I've been fair with  
7 | you, you've been fair with me thus far.

8 |           JIM: Okay.

9 |           DAVID: But you tell those guys that are  
10 | pranking around with the innocent that there's only one  
11 | thing that makes me mad, and that's when the innocent  
12 | are hurt.

13 |           JIM: I understand.

14 |           DAVID: Now, I made a deal with you with the  
15 | children.

16 |           JIM: Right.

17 |           DAVID: You tell these boneheads, these  
18 | bureaucrats, whatever they are, to open our lines up.

19 |           JIM: Okay. I'm going to see what I can do.  
20 | I know it's painful being cut off from the people you  
21 | love.

22 |           DAVID: No, the thing of it is is that we  
23 | have the right -- the radio stations are saying they  
24 | haven't heard from me since two last night, and you  
25 | know the reason why. People are wanting to call. They  
   | want to know some things. People want to --

1 JIM: David --

2 DAVID: You have a communication. We've got,  
3 we've got three lines here. You're going to be getting  
4 us another phone. As a matter of fact, we're supposed  
5 to have what, five lines altogether, Steve?

6 STEVE: We actually have three.

7 DAVID: Okay, three lines.

8 STEVE: We had four --

9 DAVID: So we can stay -- and they cut our  
10 cellular out, too.

11 JIM: Oh, yeah.

12 DAVID: So, you know, tell them guys if  
13 that's what they want is a big fight --

14 JIM: No.

15 DAVID: -- then come on.

16 JIM: David, no, we don't want to fight.

17 DAVID: Okay, that's what you're telling me.

18 JIM: Yeah.

19 DAVID: Prove it to me.

20 JIM: Well, what we've got to do is relax and  
21 I'll see what I can do. But I've got to be straight  
22 with you.

23 DAVID: I'm being straight with you now.

24 JIM: You know, that's going to be very  
25 difficult to do. And --

DAVID: Well, then this is going to be very

1 | one of these things?

2 |           JIM: How many guys? Well, I'll have to  
3 | check on that, I don't know. A couple of guys, you  
4 | know. But there's no, there's no gun on it. There's  
5 | no gun on it. It's strictly bullet-proof.

6 |           STEVE TO UNIDENTIFIED PARTY: And he said no  
7 | gun on it, it's strictly bullet-proof. I'm sure of  
8 | that.

9 |           JIM: Yeah, it is. That's the reason for it.  
10 | It's not coming in there. We're not coming in, I give  
11 | you my word. It's just a change in the perimeter. You  
12 | know, if we wanted to shoot at you, we could have been  
13 | shooting at you.

14 |           STEVE: Sure, you could.

15 |           JIM: And we haven't done that, you know,  
16 | since you and me worked out that cease fire Sunday  
17 | morning, right?

18 |           STEVE: Seems like it has been going very  
19 | well. That's why --

20 |           JIM: Right.

21 |           STEVE: -- I'm quite surprised about these  
22 | new tactics.

23 |           JIM: Well, you know, we haven't --

24 |           STEVE: More and more inches is right.

25 |           JIM: But, look, we haven't shot at you. We  
want to resolve this thing. You do, too. You're good

1 | men and you want to resolve it. We're good men and we  
2 | want to resolve it.

3 |           STEVE: Pardon? (Unidentified voice in  
4 | background not discernible.) Whatever happened with  
5 | getting the kids out?

6 |           JIM: Well, we want to get the kids out. We  
7 | want to continue to get everybody out, so we can --

8 |           STEVE: Here we're talking -- We were talking  
9 | about you and I were working about getting the kids  
10 | out --

11 |           JIM: Right.

12 |           STEVE: -- and we had this problem with the  
13 | telephone. That's what you and I were communicating  
14 | about.

15 |           JIM: Right.

16 |           STEVE: Now you're telling me about bringing  
17 | in these vehicles.

18 |           JIM: Yeah.

19 |           STEVE: So, I mean, what on earth?

20 |           JIM: Well, one thing we're doing is we're  
21 | changing the --

22 |           STEVE: I suppose maybe you could bring them  
23 | in and we'll just keep the kids and wait and see what  
24 | happens.

25 |           JIM: Well, one, one reason for it is we're  
changing the inner perimeter to the, to the FBI and

1 | they're going to be the ones holding the inner  
2 | perimeter. And the ATF agents are pulling back  
3 | farther.

4 |                 STEVE TO UNIDENTIFIED PARTY: He says the ATF  
5 | agents are pulling back and the FBI are going to be  
6 | holding the perimeter.

7 |                 UNIDENTIFIED VOICE IN BACKGROUND:  
8 | (indiscernible) going to come and kill me.)

9 |                 CHILD'S VOICE: Are you going to come and  
10 | kill me?

11 |                 JIM: Hello? No, Honey, nobody's going to  
12 | come and kill you.

13 |                 CHILD'S VOICE: Are they going to come and  
14 | kill me?

15 |                 JIM: No. No. Nobody's coming. Steve?

16 |                 MR. KORESH: Like I told you --

17 |                 JIM: Hey, David.

18 |                 MR. KORESH: Hey, Jim.

19 |                 JIM: What?

20 |                 MR. KORESH: This is in your hands now,  
21 | buddy.

22 |                 JIM: Hey, it's just --

23 |                 MR. KORESH: You're the one, you're the one  
24 | talking to me. Now, let me tell you, I made an  
25 | agreement with you and I told you straight across the  
   | table --



1 JIM: Right.

2 MR. KORESH: -- you keep these guys away.

3 Now, if they go against your will, you can't do  
4 nothing, can you?

5 JIM: No, I can do something. I'm going to  
6 work with you.

7 MR. KORESH: But you told me that you was in  
8 charge of this.

9 JIM: Oh, I'm not the commander. No, I'm not  
10 in charge.

11 MR. KORESH: Okay.

12 JIM: I'm just the guy that's talking to you.

13 MR. KORESH: Right.

14 JIM: I've got all kinds of bosses and  
15 commanders and generals around here. I mean, I've got  
16 guys with scrambled eggs and gold leaves and badges  
17 like you wouldn't believe, and they're all  
18 heavyweights, from Washington to the governor, you  
19 know. And, and everybody -- I mean, think about me. I  
20 get pressure. I've got the news, I've got the  
21 governor, I've got the vice president, I've got  
22 everybody in the world --

23 MR. KORESH: You're my, you're my voice then.

24 JIM: Well, but, you know, Dave, let me, let  
25 me ask you to do something for me. Listen to me for a  
minute.

1 MR. KORESH: I'm listening.

2 JIM: I've got a lot on my shoulders, too.

3 MR. KORESH: Uh-huh.

4 JIM: And I've had a lot of pressure.

5 MR. KORESH: Uh-huh.

6 JIM: And everybody's promising me that  
7 nothing's going to happen to you, okay? Everybody's  
8 promising me that. I'm telling you nothing's going to  
9 happen to you. I'm telling you that. Nothing at all.  
10 You've got to work with me. You are going to see these  
11 things. I'm not tricking you. They didn't show up  
12 without me telling you. I went the ex-- I got in a  
13 battle with the commanders about the guns on there. I  
14 said don't send anything out there with guns. They  
15 took their guns off.

16 I mean, it's strictly bullet-proof shield,  
17 that's it. And I know you don't like it. I sympathize  
18 with it.

19 MR. KORESH: I don't mind it. I'm just  
20 essentially saying that, you know, they're just,  
21 they're just, like I say, taking their inches. They're  
22 just, you know -- We know who's going to win this deal.

23 JIM: You know -- But, listen, you told Gary  
24 all day that you trusted me.

25 MR. KORESH: Oh, I do.

JIM: Was that true?

1 MR. KORESH: But now you're starting to, now  
2 you're starting to move off.

3 JIM: No. No.

4 MR. KORESH: Yes, you are, Jim.

5 JIM: No. Listen, I trust you and I'm  
6 telling you --

7 MR. KORESH: Yeah, I haven't broken my part  
8 of the deal.

9 JIM: Well, I'm not breaking either. We're  
10 not coming in. Our part of the deal was we're not  
11 making any aggressive action.

12 MR. KORESH: Stay on the outside of the  
13 property.

14 JIM: Well, I can't guarantee it. I'm going  
15 to try to see what I can do. I don't know where  
16 exactly they'll be positioned. What I -- Here's what I  
17 want you to do for me, okay? Let's just go one step at  
18 a time. Let the -- You're going to see them. Pass the  
19 word to all your people. When they stop, I want you to  
20 call me.

21 MR. KORESH: Or you call them and tell them  
22 where to stop.

23 JIM: No, I'm not going to call them. I want  
24 you to call me and tell me where they are, okay?

25 MR. KORESH: All right, we'll do that.

JIM: All right, you call me and tell, tell

1 | me where they are. And then let's see if there's any  
2 | problem with that. And you look at them good and you  
3 | have your men look at them good. There's no guns on  
4 | them. There's no guns.

5 |         MR. KORESH: It's, it's dark outside now.

6 |         JIM: Well, you've got night scopes.

7 |         MR. KORESH: That's right, but, like I say,  
8 | over so many hundred yards, then it's -- then you don't  
9 | know what you're dealing with. They've got a .50-  
10 | caliber aircraft barrel on it or something like that  
11 | behind an evasive plate. I mean, you know, you can't  
12 | really tell in certain distances like that.

13 |         JIM: David, listen. I've giving you 100  
14 | percent absolute guarantee, my word, repeat, okay, no  
15 | one's going to take any action. I'm giving you my  
16 | absolute solemn promise, that's it. I'm telling you it  
17 | won't happen. I'm telling you these vehicles are going  
18 | to move up, so that's what's going to happen.

19 |         MR. KORESH: So when are they going to be  
20 | here?

21 |         JIM: When they going to be there?

22 |         MR. KORESH: Yeah.

23 |         JIM: Soon, you know. Next few --

24 |         MR. KORESH: Okay, once they get situated,  
25 | we'll give you a call and tell you what's happening.  
And then let's start this evacuating children again.

1 JIM: All right. And we -- Listen, I just  
2 want -- That's great man, I'm telling you. Just hang  
3 with us. I've got to deal with all these generals  
4 and --

5 MR. KORESH: All right.

6 JIM: -- I'm trying to get them, you know, to  
7 deal with me. And we took the barrels off to  
8 demonstrate that we're not threatening you, but, you  
9 know, we don't want any other agents hurt.

10 MR. KORESH: All right. Well, we'll talk to  
11 you later then, all right?

12 JIM: All right. Now, you call me when they  
13 get stopped, okay?

14 MR. KORESH: All right.

15 JIM: All right, buddy.

16 MR. KORESH: Bye.

17 JIM: See you.

18 \* \* \* \* \*

19 STEVE: Hello?

20 JIM: Hey, Steve?

21 STEVE: Yes.

22 JIM: Hey, this is Jim. Is David there?

23 STEVE: Yes, he is.

24 JIM: Okay.

25 STEVE: Just a minute.

JIM: Okay.

1 MR. KORESH: Hello, Jim?

2 JIM: Hey, David. I've got this child here,  
3 Jenessa.

4 MR. KORESH: Uh-huh.

5 JIM: And, and she wants to talk to her mom,  
6 I think.

7 MR. KORESH: Okay, wait one second now.

8 JIM: Oh, here she is.

9 MR. KORESH: Okay, wait a minute.

10 JIM: All right.

11 MR. KORESH: Okay, what I need, what I need  
12 to know, okay, your guys are moving in, all right?

13 JIM: Are they there?

14 MR. KORESH: Yeah, they're moving in all  
15 around us.

16 JIM: Yeah.

17 MR. KORESH: So they're going to bust us in a  
18 heart --

19 JIM: No. No, we're not going to bust you  
20 tonight. No, you have my word they're not. I'm  
21 telling you they're not. This, this is straight up.  
22 Hey, would you talk to Jenessa and let her mom talk,  
23 and then you and I can talk? 'Cause she's been here a  
24 while and I think she's getting kind of tired.

25 MR. KORESH: Okay, let me talk to her.

JIM: Okay. This is David.

1 JENESSA: Hi, David.

2 MR. KORESH: Hey, how you doing?

3 JENESSA: Fine.

4 MR. KORESH: Doing fine?

5 JENESSA: Yeah.

6 MR. KORESH: Okay, that's good. All right,  
7 where, where's your sister? You with all your sisters  
8 now?

9 JENESSA: I haven't seen Tamir (phonetic sp.)  
10 yet, no.

11 MR. KORESH: Oh, Tamir ain't gone yet?

12 JENESSA: Yes, she's, she's here. I'll be  
13 seeing her soon.

14 MR. KORESH: Oh, okay. Okay, hold on a  
15 second. Jenessa, your mother, she's kind of, you know,  
16 upset right now.

17 JENESSA: Okay.

18 MR. KORESH: She says she'll talk to you all  
19 later, okay? Just have faith in God, all right?

20 JENESSA: Okay.

21 MR. KORESH: Okay, so, you know, are you  
22 strong?

23 JENESSA: Yeah.

24 MR. KORESH: That's good. All right, let me  
25 talk to Jim then.

JENESSA: Okay.

1 JIM: Thank you. Can I let her go now?

2 MR. KORESH: Yeah, she's -- Jay's upset. She  
3 says she'll talk to them later.

4 JIM: Oh, okay. All right.

5 MR. KORESH: Okay, now --

6 JIM: Now, David, I'm getting some kind of  
7 disturbing reports that, you know, you might be just  
8 really down. You know, I mean, people are telling me  
9 that, that used to know you that, you know, you're  
10 just -- you might sink real low in a situation like  
11 this. I'm kind of worried about it.

12 MR. KORESH: What do you mean, sink low?

13 JIM: Well, I mean, what we want to do is we  
14 want to get these kids out. Then we want to change and  
15 get the women out, then we want to get the men out.  
16 And, you know, I want you to make that agreement with  
17 me.

18 MR. KORESH: Well, like I told you, I said  
19 we're going to get the kids out. Then we'll do some  
20 renegotiating, okay? Because, you know, like I say,  
21 you all are saying that the main guy here that's caused  
22 all this trouble is me, right?

23 JIM: Oh, no, we're not saying that.

24 MR. KORESH: Well, come on, Jim.

25 JIM: No, hey, you're just a guy in charge.

MR. KORESH: We've been watching all the TV



1 | and everything and, I mean, they've got me painted  
2 | pretty bad. Half statements, quarter statements, you  
3 | know --

4 |           JIM: Well, they do that. I mean, they --

5 |           MR. KORESH: I know, but that, that creates a  
6 | tenor in the public which -- But anyway --

7 |           JIM: Well, listen, you, you share with me --  
8 | Now, I've told you how I felt. You share with me your  
9 | thoughts and concerns about what's going on. I mean,  
10 | I, I guess I'm -- what I'm asking for --

11 |           MR. KORESH: Is what I want to do --

12 |           JIM: I want you, I want you to open up to  
13 | me, but I don't want you to, you know, I want you to be  
14 | straight out. I, I can't, I can't decipher the  
15 | scripture. I'm just not a theologian and I just want  
16 | you to tell me straight out what are your concerns,  
17 | what do you, what do you want to do? What can I do to  
18 | help you?

19 |           MR. KORESH: Well, where we're at right now  
20 | is I want all these people to have a chance to think,  
21 | every last one of them, every man, every woman, you  
22 | know. And I want time, I want time for people to  
23 | think.

24 |           JIM: Yeah.

25 |           MR. KORESH: I want time for people to live.  
I don't want any more people hurt. And I want to have

1 | time just to sit here, lay here --

2 |           JIM: All right.

3 |           MR. KORESH: -- and let whatever happens to  
4 | me happen. But I want these people to have time to  
5 | where, where I'm gone -- You know, that may be asking  
6 | too much for you. I know you all want to get in here  
7 | and really bust us up quick, but these people here,  
8 | they've got to make their own decisions. And if I have  
9 | influenced them, you know, then, like I say, if you  
10 | just give me enough time because -- to let these wounds  
11 | take their effect and just let me die --

12 |           JIM: But, you know --

13 |           MR. KORESH: Jim, look --

14 |           JIM: David, listen.

15 |           MR. KORESH: No, Jim, listen.

16 |           JIM: This has been painful for us. Come on.

17 |           MR. KORESH: Jim, listen, listen, Jim,  
18 | there's nothing that hurts me more than being called a  
19 | cult leader, all right? I spoke the truth but you  
20 | don't know that.

21 |           JIM: Yeah, but we didn't call you that.

22 |           MR. KORESH: I know. Jim, listen --

23 |           JIM: You -- Hey, those news media, you guys,  
24 | come on.

25 |           MR. KORESH: Look, Jim, let me explain  
something. People do have a lot of influence and I

1 | understand that.

2 |           JIM: Yeah.

3 |           MR. KORESH: Jeremiah says wound heal that  
4 | trusses from the arm of flesh. So all I'm asking is  
5 | that you --

6 |           JIM: But, David --

7 |           MR. KORESH: -- keep the guys off.

8 |           JIM: Oh, yeah, but let me, let me ask you  
9 | something. The position you're taking, okay, without  
10 | letting us give you any medical care --

11 |           MR. KORESH: I don't want the medical care,  
12 | all right?

13 |           JIM: I understand, but just listen --

14 |           MR. KORESH: I've been doing my work ever  
15 | since 1985, all right?

16 |           JIM: Um-hum. But just listen for just a  
17 | minute.

18 |           MR. KORESH: If I'm wrong, people like me  
19 | don't deserve to live, okay?

20 |           JIM: Listen, listen --

21 |           MR. KORESH: Do you understand me, Jim?

22 |           JIM: David, I do, but I, I've been a good  
23 | listener and I'm just asking you to listen to me for  
24 | just a minute. The way, you know, you've got this  
25 | wound in there and you're suffering, it's almost like  
   | you're hurting yourself. And --

1 MR. KORESH: I asked for it, didn't I?

2 JIM: Yeah, but, you know, I'm a Christian  
3 man and I know about Jesus and he didn't kill himself.  
4 Jesus didn't hurt himself.

5 MR. KORESH: No, he died on the cross.

6 JIM: Right. And he died trying to spread  
7 the word.

8 MR. KORESH: Yeah, and --

9 JIM: And --

10 MR. KORESH: Let me tell you something.

11 JIM: -- if you're dying, you can't advance  
12 the word.

13 MR. KORESH: I can't advance the word anyway.  
14 See, with the news media, with the coverage, you  
15 understand, slander is something that's been used --  
16 Look, the best thing to do right now is to give these  
17 people a chance.

18 JIM: I want them all to have a chance.

19 MR. KORESH: Yeah. And those who've done  
20 injustice, I mean, you know, they've got to, they've  
21 got to give themselves over to the judicial system.  
22 We know that. But, remember, I'm the bad guy, okay, as  
23 far as the world thinks. So just give these people  
24 time. You know, send some of these guys home. You  
25 know, keep, keep a perimeter up. You know, always, you  
know, make sure nobody leaves, you know.

1 JIM: All right, David, let me --

2 MR. KORESH: Give us time to get hungry, give  
3 us time to get thirsty. You know what I'm saying?

4 JIM: David, will you be straight with me?

5 MR. KORESH: I'm straight.

6 JIM: Are you going to commit suicide?

7 MR. KORESH: I'm not going to commit suicide.

8 JIM: Your word? Your word?

9 MR. KORESH: My word is the word.

10 JIM: You're going to come out of there?

11 MR. KORESH: Well, I want to lay here and let  
12 this take care of me.

13 JIM: Well, that's committing suicide.

14 MR. KORESH: No, it's not.

15 JIM: Sure, it is. It's killing yourself.

16 MR. KORESH: Look --

17 JIM: Jesus didn't kill himself.

18 MR. KORESH: Look, let's, let's, let's get  
19 back on this one thing. God sits on the throne in  
20 heaven, right?

21 JIM: Man, I'm really worried about you.

22 MR. KORESH: Listen, Jim, does he or does he  
23 not?

24 JIM: Would you -- Let me ask you this.

25 MR. KORESH: Question: Does he or does he  
not?

1 JIM: He loves you, sure, he does.

2 MR. KORESH: No, does he sit on a throne or  
3 not?

4 JIM: Sure, he does.

5 MR. KORESH: All right. Does he have a book  
6 with seven seals?

7 JIM: Yes, he does.

8 MR. KORESH: Is Psalm 45 the first seal?

9 JIM: Well, I'm not sure. But if you say so,  
10 I'll take your word.

11 MR. KORESH: You can't do that. That makes  
12 you like a cult follower.

13 JIM: David, you're being real straight with  
14 me and I've just got to ask you this question, okay?  
15 Are you going to let any of your other people kill  
16 themselves or die in there? I've got to know, buddy.

17 MR. KORESH: I'm not going to do that.

18 JIM: I've got to know.

19 MR. KORESH: We are giving a message. We  
20 want to give a message and a witness. I want these  
21 people to have a chance to sit this out, think about  
22 it, you know.

23 JIM: Well, what's going to happen if you  
24 die? You tell me, if you die from that wound, an  
25 infection, I want you to tell me what's going to  
happen.

1 MR. KORESH: Well, I'm not going to be around  
2 any more, am I, to influence anybody, right?

3 JIM: Well, what's going to happen to your  
4 people? Are they going to walk out?

5 MR. KORESH: We have to see, Jim. Like I  
6 said, I'm not a cult leader. I'm a Bible teacher,  
7 okay? Nobody ever is committed to do what I ask or do  
8 what I say, okay? People do what they want to do.

9 JIM: Yeah.

10 MR. KORESH: Okay? Now, if you let the  
11 people think, you know, they're all scared around here  
12 now --

13 JIM: Just --

14 MR. KORESH: You've shown them a big arm, you  
15 know.

16 JIM: You know what I'm trying to do? I'm  
17 trying to let you -- I'm asking you to let me look  
18 inside your people and you to see what's going to go  
19 on, because unless you do, then, you know, it's going  
20 to be hard to, to help.

21 MR. KORESH: Well, I'm telling you what  
22 you'll do. Just give us some time, give us time, you  
23 know. That's all I'm asking. Give us time. You know,  
24 you've all done -- you've all been enraged a lot of  
25 times, you know. Don't burn our building down.

JIM: No, we won't do that.

1 MR. KORESH: Don't, don't shoot us all up.  
2 Give these people a chance before God to weigh out  
3 whether what they've learned in the scripture is the  
4 truth or, you know, whether maybe they have second  
5 thoughts: But they've got to, they've got to have that  
6 time.

7 JIM: David, if you die, you're leaving your  
8 people helpless.

9 MR. KORESH: Look, they're God's people.

10 JIM: But if --

11 MR. KORESH: I'm just an instrument, okay?

12 JIM: Yeah.

13 MR. KORESH: I'm just another human being, an  
14 instrument, okay? You don't understand. This is not  
15 no glory thing. This is life.

16 JIM: But if you live, you can spread the  
17 word.

18 MR. KORESH: I cannot. They'll lock me up in  
19 the jail for 100 years. You know, they blame me for  
20 everything, you know.

21 JIM: But didn't, didn't you get acquitted on  
22 the trial you had in 1980?

23 MR. KORESH: Look, we were innocent. In the  
24 court session, you're not supposed to have a  
25 prosecuting attorney and another friend on the jury.  
And the two black guys talked to me later and said that



1 | between that black guy and Chebaz (phonetic sp.), they  
2 | hung that. The other jurists knew that I was innocent  
3 | all the way through.

4 |           JIM: But they acquitted you, didn't they?

5 |           MR. KORESH: Yeah. But nothing like this  
6 | happened.

7 |           JIM: Yeah. But you'll still get a day in  
8 | court, come on.

9 |           MR. KORESH: Look, I know, and I've also  
10 | known about money. Come on. Jim, let's, let's just  
11 | talk like this. Let's just say give these people a  
12 | chance to think, okay?

13 |           JIM: Okay. I'll tell you what I'm going to  
14 | do. I'm going to do -- I'm, I'm going to let them to  
15 | think, but I'd like you to start discussing with all  
16 | your people that, you know, just like you told me,  
17 | they're coming out of there. And I want them to get  
18 | their minds right, that they're coming out of there.  
19 | And I want you to set a plan for them to come out of  
20 | there.

21 |           MR. KORESH: Look, Jim --

22 |           JIM: Come on, buddy.

23 |           MR. KORESH: -- like you said --

24 |           JIM: Trust me now.

25 |           MR. KORESH: -- a plan. Just let me lay here  
and let nature take its course with me, all right?

1 JIM: Yeah, but you know, you know something?

2 MR. KORESH: That may be too much time for  
3 you.

4 JIM: No.

5 MR. KORESH: But if you move in too quick,  
6 then these people are going to retaliate.

7 JIM: Listen, I want your folks to have a  
8 chance in life. And, you know, you know how we were  
9 yesterday, where we couldn't get anywhere, we didn't  
10 seem to get anywhere until you and I started to make  
11 some agreements about the children coming out.

12 MR. KORESH: That's right. And like with  
13 Gary last night, I kept telling him over and over what  
14 our plan was, and he didn't seem to understand. So  
15 then, all of a sudden, what happens is that all this  
16 time, you know, we've been sitting and talking and,  
17 and, you know, back and forth, and, you know, that's  
18 why I'm -- You know, we hear on the, we hear on the TV  
19 that all the children are out.

20 JIM: Oh, well, those TV --

21 MR. KORESH: There is such a, there is such a  
22 screw-up in communication. That's why I let you talk  
23 to Daylind (phonetic)

24 JIM: Oh, I know.

25 MR. KORESH: You know?

JIM: But, you know, what I'm, what I'm

1 | trying to say is once we had an agreement about what  
2 | was going to happen, you made it happen. You know,  
3 | you've got a strong will, and what I'm saying --

4 |           MR. KORESH: And I explained to you why.  
5 | Because the children don't have decisions in them.

6 |           JIM: I know it, but, but what I'm saying is  
7 | if you could make an agreement with your people that  
8 | they're walking out of there and you could --

9 |           MR. KORESH: I am not going to tell them what  
10 | to do. I never have and never will. I show them out  
11 | of a book what God teaches. Then it's for them to  
12 | decide.

13 |           JIM: David, these, these kids need their  
14 | parents and we want everybody to be safe. How about  
15 | the women? Can -- Will you let them come out of there?

16 |           MR. KORESH: Hey, haven't, haven't Sita and  
17 | them already come out?

18 |           JIM: Oh, yeah, but I mean, I mean come out  
19 | and actually stay out.

20 |           MR. KORESH: Yeah, but the thing of it is is  
21 | that if they wanted to, they, they could.

22 |           JIM: Well, I, I think they feel like they  
23 | can't because you don't want them to.

24 |           MR. KORESH: No, no, no, no. Let's stop that  
25 | now.

          JIM: Okay. I mean, I think your will is so

1 | strong that -- and they love you so much that they,  
2 | they wouldn't go unless you sent them. You know what I  
3 | mean?

4 | MR. KORESH: Jim --

5 | JIM: David, give me a sign and send, send a  
6 | woman with some children.

7 | MR. KORESH: Jim --

8 | JIM: Give me a sign.

9 | MR. KORESH: -- I'm not going to play that  
10 | game.

11 | JIM: Come on, give me a sign. Send a woman  
12 | with some children.

13 | MR. KORESH: Jim, your psychology's really  
14 | rusty.

15 | JIM: Hey, I'm no psychologist, I'm a  
16 | policeman.

17 | MR. KORESH: I know. You're, you're a  
18 | psychologist. You have to have the best psychology to  
19 | be a policeman.

20 | JIM: I'm a policeman, that's all I am. And  
21 | all I'm trying to do is save some people from getting  
22 | hurt.

23 | MR. KORESH: Okay, exactly. That's what I  
24 | want to do. Now, are you going to give us some time or  
25 | not?

JIM: Oh, yeah, I'm going to give you --

1 | Hey --

2 |           MR. KORESH: Or are these guys going to come  
3 | in here and --

4 |           JIM: No, you've got the time, buddy. You've  
5 | got it. You've got the time. Now, you're going to see  
6 | those vehicles, like I told you, but you've got --  
7 | nothing else is happening. Listen, are the, are the  
8 | mothers worried about the kids? Are they upset or  
9 | anything?

10 |           MR. KORESH: Aren't the, aren't the, aren't  
11 | the mothers talking to the children?

12 |           JIM: Yeah. Oh --

13 |           MR. KORESH: Jay is. You know, Jay may come  
14 | out later, you know.

15 |           JIM: Is Jay a mother?

16 |           MR. KORESH: Yeah, she's, she's the mother of  
17 | Jenessa.

18 |           JIM: Okay.

19 |           MR. KORESH: She says she doesn't want to  
20 | talk to them right now.

21 |           JIM: Okay. Would you --

22 |           MR. KORESH: And she might come out, you  
23 | know.

24 |           JIM: Um-hum. Are we going to get any other  
25 | kids out tonight?

          MR. KORESH: Well, I'm thinking about it. I

1 | mean, you know, what, what are we doing now? Where are  
2 | we at?

3 |           JIM: You're great, man. Hang in there,  
4 | Buddy. Do it, come on.

5 |           MR. KORESH: Where, where's the van at now?

6 |           JIM: Oh, I can get the van there if you want  
7 | to do it. Shoot.

8 |           MR. KORESH: I'll send a couple more out. Go  
9 | get the van.

10 |           JIM: All right. I'll get the van lined up.

11 |           MR. KORESH: Okay. Well, give me a call when  
12 | it gets here.

13 |           JIM: All right. You line the kids up and  
14 | I'll call you back. Let's see, let me look at my watch  
15 | here. I'll call you at quarter to eight, twenty  
16 | minutes.

17 |           MR. KORESH: All right.

18 |           JIM: Is that enough time to hug them and  
19 | kiss them, get their coats, and at quarter to eight  
20 | have them ready to walk out?

21 |           MR. KORESH: Okay.

22 |           JIM: Buddy, I'll call -- Man, you're great.

23 |           MR. KORESH: Bye, Jim.

24 |           JIM: Thanks. Look, don't give up on me.  
25 | Hang in there.

          MR. KORESH: I'm not giving up on you.

1 JIM: All right. Hang in there.

2 MR. KORESH: I'm just putting my children in  
3 your hands.

4 JIM: Hey, we're taking care of them, too.

5 MR. KORESH: Okay.

6 JIM: And, listen, if you see --

7 MR. KORESH: Hey, you know our phone, we  
8 can't even call you now?

9 JIM: You can't?

10 MR. KORESH: No.

11 JIM: I've got to give you a number?

12 MR. KORESH: No. What I'm saying is that we  
13 can't call anybody now. We asked you to open up some  
14 lines for us. Now we can't call anybody. Every time  
15 we dial three digits, it goes da, da, da.

16 JIM: Yeah. Hey, listen, I've got --

17 MR. KORESH: Here's Steve. Here.

18 JIM: I've got to line these cars up and --

19 STEVE: Jim.

20 JIM: Hey, Steve?

21 STEVE: I wanted to call you, you know, like,  
22 say, five, ten minutes ago, and every time I get to the  
23 third digit now it, it's over, it's done.

24 JIM: Oh, all right, I'll fix it. I'll, I'll  
25 get that corrected right away.

STEVE: All right. Yeah, because he was

1 | wanting to talk, I did, and we were trying to get  
2 | something worked out here.

3 |           JIM: Oh, hey, my apologies.

4 |           STEVE: Okay.

5 |           JIM: I, I, I just -- We had a good  
6 | conversation. We're making a lot of progress. And  
7 | I've got to take a break to set up a car.

8 |           STEVE: Okay.

9 |           JIM: And, and hang in there with me now.

10 |           STEVE: I'm -- That's that I've been trying  
11 | to do.

12 |           JIM: Okay.

13 |           STEVE: I want to.

14 |           JIM: Just be patient. I'm giving you my  
15 | word everything's okay.

16 |           STEVE: Okay.

17 |           JIM: Trust me now. Just hang in there.

18 |           STEVE: Okay.

19 |           JIM: Keep everybody calm. We're going to  
20 | get everybody through this.

21 |           STEVE: I'm trying to do that.

22 |           JIM: You're a good man. Steve, hang in  
23 | there.

24 |           STEVE: Okay.

25 |           JIM: I'll call you back at about quarter to  
eight.



1 STEVE: Okay. Thanks, Jim.

2 JIM: And then I'm going to get the phone  
3 fixed.

4 STEVE: All right.

5 JIM: All right, see you.

6 STEVE: Bye.

7 \* \* \* \* \*

8 JIM: And he told me he couldn't dial this  
9 number. Did you check on that?

10 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: I haven't checked  
11 on it.

12 \* \* \* \* \*

13 STEVE: Hello?

14 JIM: Steve?

15 STEVE: Yes. Jim.

16 JIM: Hey, how you doing?

17 STEVE: Well, I was kind of waiting for your  
18 call there.

19 JIM: Yeah. I'm sorry, I got tied up setting  
20 up that car.

21 STEVE: Okay.

22 JIM: I've got a car out there that's ready.

23 STEVE: Oh, it's already out there and ready?

24 JIM: Well, no, it's, it's not at the water  
25 tower, but it's, it's just about, you know, about an  
eighth of a mile.

1 STEVE: About an eighth of a mile?

2 JIM: Um-hum. Have you got the kids ready?

3 STEVE: We're a little -- Jim, man, I mean,  
4 you know, we thought we were getting it worked out  
5 again, bŭt tell me if it's true or false, we just heard  
6 on the radio that they're planning on hitting us at, at  
7 eight o'clock, which is in three minutes.

8 JIM: Oh, not true. You stay with me.  
9 We'll, we'll talk. Nothing'll happen. I'm serious.

10 STEVE: I mean, I believed you from --

11 JIM: Absolutely.

12 STEVE: -- the beginning.

13 JIM: Oh, that's baloney. I'm telling you, I  
14 don't know where those people -- I think they just sit  
15 there and make up stuff. They make up stuff.

16 STEVE: I know it. Well, even about David.  
17 There was this -- Remember back in '87 this crazy  
18 what's his name dug up a body. Roden?

19 JIM: Roden, yeah.

20 STEVE: They said we did that.

21 JIM: Oh.

22 STEVE: I mean, it's incredible. I mean, I  
23 mean, the news is just ripping us apart with things  
24 that aren't even remotely close.

25 JIM: Well, I'll tell you what. When we --  
After we resolve this thing, you're going to have a

1 | chance to clear all that up. And I --

2 |           STEVE: Well, I hope so.

3 |           JIM: I hope you do because it really makes  
4 | me angry the way they try to slander you and  
5 | everything. And it's wrong, but, you know --

6 |           STEVE: Well, you know, a lot of these people  
7 | are -- they've having, you know, they're, they're  
8 | trying to think and decide what they want to do. You  
9 | know, there's a lot of them here that are that way  
10 | and --

11 |           JIM: Yeah.

12 |           STEVE: And I heard what he had to say and  
13 | he's said it before. And, you know, a lot of them  
14 | are -- they're so puzzled and confused and --

15 |           JIM: Yeah. Well, I understand that. I  
16 | really -- And I sympathize.

17 |           STEVE: And they're saying that he's up and  
18 | walking around. That's baloney. Every time you --  
19 | He's never moved.

20 |           JIM: No, I know he's never moved.

21 |           STEVE: You can even tell by his voice. I  
22 | mean, I don't get -- I don't even know where they got  
23 | that from.

24 |           JIM: Steve, let me ask you something  
25 | straight --

          STEVE: Yeah.

1 JIM: -- straight up, okay?

2 STEVE: Okay.

3 JIM: I'm worried about David. I'm concerned  
4 about him. I, I feel like his wound is going to get  
5 infected. I've talked to him directly about this.

6 STEVE: Right.

7 JIM: I feel like he might die. If that  
8 happens, what, what are you going to do?

9 STEVE: Well, what I'm going to do --

10 JIM: Are you going to, are you going to let  
11 me --

12 STEVE: Well, I'm going to keep on  
13 communicating with you. That's why I wanted to, you  
14 know, right from the beginning, right with the  
15 children, right on through to see what these people  
16 want to -- I want to try to help everyone make up their  
17 mind.

18 JIM: Yeah, but I want you to walk out of  
19 there with everybody.

20 STEVE: Well, I'd sure like to.

21 JIM: I mean, that's what we want to do. And  
22 I, I want to save David and you want to save David.

23 STEVE: But he really -- This is true.

24 JIM: I mean, let's, let's get down to the --  
25 We've got to get down to the brass tacks. You know,  
when I was in Tennessee, we used to say we've got to

1 | see how the cow eats the cabbage here, you know.

2 |           STEVE: Right.

3 |           JIM: I, I don't want to dance around with  
4 | you. I mean, I am not -- I'm just a policeman and I  
5 | don't want to see nobody hurt.

6 |           STEVE: Yeah.

7 |           JIM: And I told -- I asked David straight  
8 | out what are you going to do, Dave? I mean, Jesus  
9 | didn't commit suicide.

10 |           STEVE: Well, he doesn't want to do that.

11 |           JIM: Yeah, but I'm afraid he's letting that  
12 | wound draw him weaker and weaker. He's going to get an  
13 | infection. He's going to get where we can't bring him  
14 | back. He's going to get where we can't --

15 |           STEVE: I mean, after all the slander in the  
16 | world and everything he's gone through, I mean --

17 |           JIM: The guy's gone through so --

18 |           STEVE: All he's wanted to do is speak and  
19 | open up and love -- to show people what, what God's  
20 | going to do, bizarre as it seems in town.

21 |           JIM: He's got a chance to make a difference.  
22 | He's got a chance to make a difference now and, and you  
23 | have a chance.

24 |           STEVE: Let me ask him, do you want to talk  
25 | to Jim? Pardon? (Unidentified male voice in  
background not discernible.) He said all this

1 excitement's getting to him. He looks pretty weak.

2 JIM: Hey, I wish we could, I wish we could  
3 fool all those news reporters and just -- with their  
4 reports on the attacks and you all could just all get  
5 in a group and walk out. And, you know, I really wish  
6 we could just get this thing resolved peacefully.

7 STEVE: Well, that's what he -- You know,  
8 that's what they want to do, but they're, they're --  
9 Actually, the truth is they're terrified.

10 JIM: They're terrified?

11 STEVE: Well, yeah.

12 JIM: Yeah.

13 STEVE: I mean, you know, a person doesn't  
14 want to say that, but, you know, they are.

15 JIM: Yeah. I understand.

16 STEVE: They're afraid to move. They've seen  
17 all the movement outside, you know, the vehicles. Not  
18 only the three, we heard on the radio that another four  
19 or five are coming from wherever --

20 JIM: Well, that -- You know, all that  
21 perimeter stuff, Steve, it really -- I, I appreciate  
22 your concern, but I'm telling you it's nothing. This  
23 thing is inside. I mean, it's inside you and, and, and  
24 David. If you want to -- If you guys wanted to get  
25 together and walk out, it's over.

STEVE: Well, I mean, that's what the talk

1 | has been, right, in the whole afternoon.

2 |           JIM: Well, I know. But, see --

3 |           STEVE: You're just keeping on saying well --  
4 | And they're saying they're afraid to make any move  
5 | because of what, you know, everybody's listening to the  
6 | radios and all that.

7 |           JIM: Yeah, that's a bunch of baloney,  
8 | though. The radios don't control us.

9 |           STEVE: I know they don't, but, you know,  
10 | there are -- and there are many things that we have  
11 | heard them saying that ended up being so, you know.

12 |           JIM: Yeah. That, that's all baloney. And,  
13 | look, I'm looking at my watch and it's two minutes  
14 | after eight. Is anybody assaulting you?

15 |           STEVE: No.

16 |           JIM: It's not true. It's baloney. I'm just  
17 | trying to put a straight, you know, be as straight as I  
18 | possibly can.

19 |           STEVE: Yeah.

20 |           JIM: You know, you guys are knowledgeable  
21 | theologians and stuff and it's hard for me to talk on  
22 | that level. I mean, I don't understand all those  
23 | things. I mean, I appreciate them, I'm a Christian,  
24 | but you know what I'm saying.

25 |           STEVE: Yeah. You know, I would care about  
you whether you were or not, 'cause, you know,

1 everybody follows the dictates of their conscience and,  
2 you know, they try to do it the best they can with what  
3 they see, where they're at in this life and I don't --  
4 You know, I've never condemned or judged a person for  
5 that. I mean, one thing I have learned from the Bible,  
6 it says judge not that he be not judged. So I don't  
7 know what makes another person tick, you know. It's  
8 not been given to me to look at another and then say  
9 they're right or wrong or whatever.

10 JIM: Isn't, isn't, isn't there teachings  
11 also that sometimes, you know, you make peace or throw  
12 down the sword or, you know, you, you love? And that's  
13 what you guys are trying to do.

14 STEVE: Well, that -- You know, like, you  
15 know, that's what -- That hasn't even come up, you  
16 know. We've been talking about a lot of issues, we  
17 really have been, and --

18 JIM: Okay. All right, just a minute. I'm  
19 sorry, Steve, wait a minute. He's hollering at me.  
20 Okay. Hey, they're ready to send the car up. Would  
21 you just tell -- ask David to pick what kids he wants  
22 and maybe start getting them ready?

23 STEVE: Okay. Just a minute. (Unidentified  
24 voices in background not discernible.)

25 [gap]

STEVE: It's very confusing to know even what



1 to do.

2 JIM: Yeah. Well, look --

3 STEVE: The mothers, you know, they're  
4 standing there scared even -- You know, he, he's been  
5 saying well, do you mind sending your two now and, you  
6 know, some of them are, are talking about they don't  
7 know if they should go along now or what, you know.

8 JIM: Why don't they all come in a group?  
9 I'll guarantee --

10 STEVE: Well, see, some of them want to, but  
11 there's some that don't. And they're trying -- You  
12 know what I mean? They're, they're confused.

13 JIM: Okay, I understand. And let's -- Maybe  
14 we -- I don't want to move too fast.

15 STEVE: You know what I mean? It just  
16 happened yesterday. That's why -- And, you know, there  
17 was starting -- they were starting to calm down  
18 because -- I'll tell you what, the greatest relief came  
19 was when you started talking to us the way you were all  
20 the way through and, and last night. I mean, everybody  
21 felt good about it, they did, about you and the whole  
22 thing. And then with Gary, well, you know, there was a  
23 little bit there, but when you got back on the phone,  
24 we thought we'd just continue right on with it.

25 JIM: You know, I've talked to all these  
commanders.

1           STEVE: But I'll tell you the truth and, you  
2 know, it kind of freaked us out, though, about those  
3 lines, because, you know, they're parents, they wanted  
4 to talk to their kids --

5           JIM: I appreciate that.

6           STEVE: -- and say come on out and, you know,  
7 we love you and all that. Some of them are here saying  
8 they wanted to talk to their, their folks yet. And, so  
9 I mean, I didn't know what to say to them. That's why  
10 finally we get on the phone and say well, can't you  
11 leave these lines open for us.

12           JIM: Yeah. Well, let me ask you this,  
13 Steve.

14           STEVE: Okay.

15           JIM: If, if some of the people, some women  
16 and maybe some children, wanted to come out, maybe they  
17 could get in a group and walk out. I'll guarantee  
18 their safe conduct. They could call you, they could  
19 tell you we're fine.

20           STEVE: Okay, I'm sorry. I didn't want to  
21 interrupt you but there is a mother here, she wants to  
22 send her two out right now.

23           JIM: Okay. Let me talk to her.

24           STEVE: Okay, just a minute. What, what's --  
25 And Jamie? (Talking to someone else.) Okay, there's  
two that -- two of the mothers that want to send each

1 out one right now.

2 JIM: All right, listen -- Okay, Steve.

3 STEVE: Okay, yeah.

4 JIM: Now, let me ask you a question.

5 STEVE: Okay.

6 JIM: Does that mother want to come out?

7 Just ask her.

8 STEVE: They're sitting there talking, you  
9 know, they're down at the other end. I'm looking at  
10 them from a distance and I, I see them talking, but I'm  
11 not sure what they want to do.

12 JIM: I don't -- I mean, okay, listen --

13 STEVE: You know, a person, you know, I'm  
14 waiting to see what they want to do. We've told them,  
15 you know, you think through it. You know, you chose to  
16 come here. This happened, you know, we didn't want it  
17 to happen, so, you know, they're all giving thoughts to  
18 what they want to do and, and, in fact, we're kind of  
19 waiting to see what do you want to do. That's why  
20 David, he's so tired of it all that -- I heard what he  
21 said and, you know, he wants them all to be so free and  
22 to be able to say well, okay, it is or not and --

23 JIM: Well, listen, Steve, we want them to be  
24 safe and we want them to be with their kids. And David  
25 told me, now, he told me this many -- five times, okay?

STEVE: All right.

1 JIM: Now, this -- there's a guy that's never  
2 broke his word to me.

3 STEVE: Okay.

4 JIM: I don't care what the newspaper said, I  
5 don't care what the radio says, I'm just telling you  
6 what Jim Kavanaugh says, and every time he told me  
7 something he stood by it.

8 STEVE: Right.

9 JIM: And he told me that if there was  
10 someone in there who wanted to come out, he would let  
11 them come out.

12 STEVE: That is -- That always will be that  
13 way.

14 JIM: Okay. Now, so what I'm asking is as a  
15 sign of good faith and --

16 STEVE: Just a minute.

17 JIM: Yeah?

18 STEVE: Oh, Brian and Jake. Oh, excuse me,  
19 Brian and Jake, did they ever come?

20 JIM: Oh, Brian and Jake.

21 STEVE: I guess not. In fact, they were --  
22 Remember, you -- we were talking to you and you never  
23 got back to us on that, 'cause they're still -- I just  
24 found out they were -- all this time they've been  
25 standing there waiting.

JIM: Yeah.

1 STEVE: I didn't know that. They're down at  
2 the -- or near the entrance even.

3 JIM: Are they, are they ready now?

4 STEVE: Yeah.

5 JIM: Okay.

6 STEVE: Yeah. I didn't even know that. They  
7 said -- They told me they've been waiting all this -- I  
8 totally forgot about it myself.

9 JIM: All right. Well, we were supposed to  
10 get those two earlier, right?

11 STEVE: Exactly.

12 JIM: Okay. Well --

13 STEVE: And you said --

14 JIM: -- why don't you do this, Steve?

15 STEVE: Okay.

16 JIM: Since the other mother was anxious to  
17 get their two --

18 STEVE: Right.

19 JIM: -- put their coats on them --

20 STEVE: All right.

21 JIM: Clear it with David, now. I don't --

22 STEVE: No, he said -- No, he --

23 JIM: Okay, he said --

24 STEVE: -- he agrees, he says --

25 JIM: Then put those four kids together,  
'cause we were supposed to get two earlier and we

1 | messed up.

2 |           STEVE: Those, those two, they're still  
3 | talking now. They don't -- They're trying to figure  
4 | out should one send her two. They were talking about  
5 | maybe sending a little one with an older one. That's  
6 | what they're working on, and they said send these two.  
7 | And they're trying to decide. You know, it's like they  
8 | want to hug them yet and hang on --

9 |           JIM: Sure.

10 |          STEVE: -- another minute or two. So --

11 |          JIM: They're good, they're good mothers.  
12 | Come on.

13 |          STEVE: Okay, so the two are ready. Brian,  
14 | how old is he? How old is Brian? Two years old. And  
15 | Jake, he's how old? Did we give you any information on  
16 | them?

17 |          JIM: No.

18 |          STEVE: Okay, Jake is nine. He's nine years  
19 | old.

20 |          JIM: Okay.

21 |          STEVE: And they're brothers to Chrissy and  
22 | to Scott that already, you know, you have them with  
23 | you.

24 |          JIM: Okay.

25 |          STEVE: Let me -- I'm going to try to help  
them get going here. I guess they're, they're still --

1 (Unidentified female voice in background not  
2 discernible.) Yeah? Which one?

3 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: David.

4 STEVE: Oh, they were wondering what  
5 happened, how come they're not playing that message any  
6 more on the radio.

7 JIM: We did play it. Do you have the radio  
8 on?

9 STEVE: Yeah, they do, they do.

10 JIM: Okay. We need the, we need the message  
11 played. They didn't hear it the last time we played  
12 it, the scripture message.

13 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: You want the  
14 message played?

15 JIM: Yeah. Tell --

16 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Can we get the  
17 message played?

18 STEVE: Jim.

19 JIM: Okay, you've got -- Who'd you tell?  
20 Okay, okay, we're taking care of it.

21 STEVE: Okay, good.

22 JIM: They did play it. I don't know, maybe,  
23 you know, you missed it.

24 STEVE: Yeah.

25 JIM: But is -- those other mothers there?

STEVE: They're over at the other -- I can

1 | see them. They're a little distance away from me.  
2 | They're over there. I can see them talking and  
3 | discussing it right now.

4 |           JIM: Sit the phone down and talk to them,  
5 | and if they want to send them with Brian and Jake,  
6 | because we messed up, we'll, we'll -- you know, and  
7 | David said it's okay, then we'll take those four.

8 |           STEVE: I, I think he wants to keep on going  
9 | like he was. I see him over here motioning, trying to  
10 | have these two get another two ready so that they can  
11 | go right, right almost after.

12 |           JIM: Yeah, okay. Yeah, two by two's fine.

13 |           STEVE: Okay. Let's -- Okay, let's get these  
14 | two. Where are they at now?

15 |           UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Brian and Jake.

16 |           STEVE: Where are they?

17 |           JIM: Can you --

18 |           STEVE: It just said on the radio that  
19 | there's only 10 children here and they already have  
20 | them, which is -- I believe you're going to find out  
21 | how many. There are a lot of them.

22 |           JIM: That's not true. We know that.

23 |           STEVE: Okay.

24 |           JIM: You guys told me that wasn't the case.

25 | Okay, can we --

          STEVE: Okay.



1 JIM: Let me check on the car. Hold on,  
2 Steve.

3 STEVE: All right.

4 JIM: Have you got the car?

5 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Yeah.

6 JIM: Okay, are the kids ready to walk out?

7 STEVE: Are they ready to walk out now?

8 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Yes.

9 STEVE: Yes, they are.

10 JIM: Okay.

11 STEVE: Sita's right here.

12 JIM: All right. Well, let me talk to her.

13 STEVE: Okay, here she is.

14 SITA: Jim?

15 JIM: Sita, how are you?

16 SITA: Jittery, but --

17 JIM: Listen, let me tell you something,  
18 don't be jittery and don't be scared. All that reports  
19 on the radio is rubbish, okay? You hear me?

20 SITA: Yes.

21 JIM: The, the -- You will see some vehicles  
22 out there. I told David and I, and I told Steve and  
23 they know that it's nothing, okay? Nobody's coming in  
24 there. Now, I've got a car at the -- I'm going to send  
25 it to the water tower right now.

SITA: Okay, we'll see you down there then.

1 JIM: Hey, listen, let me ask you something?

2 SITA: Yeah?

3 JIM: Do you want to come out of there with  
4 the kids?

5 SITA: Hey, I got, I got lots of kids to  
6 bring.

7 JIM: Okay. Well, David said anybody who  
8 wanted to come out could come out. Well, you ask him.

9 SITA: I already asked him and it's up to me.

10 JIM: Okay.

11 SITA: Right now I'm concerned about the  
12 children.

13 JIM: Well, why don't you bring the -- your  
14 kids and come out?

15 SITA: I, I was the first one.

16 JIM: Okay.

17 SITA: See, me, I was the first one. Crystal  
18 and Angelica.

19 JIM: Right. I know, yeah. I know, you,  
20 you're doing great. You're working with us.

21 SITA: And, you know, I was tempted -- I love  
22 those -- I love all those kids.

23 JIM: I know. They need you. These -- Let  
24 me tell you something, Sita, these kids need you. They  
25 need all their mothers. I wish you could look at -- I  
mean, they're beautiful, these kids, but they've got to

1 | difficult because, you know, what you say you want to  
2 | do, you're telling me you don't want to do.

3 |           JIM: Well, no, I didn't say that. Do I have  
4 | one, one more little children in here? Is there one  
5 | more child here? No, we, we already brought him in.  
6 | We're bringing another child in? Okay. (Talking to  
7 | someone else.) I have another one of the children here  
8 | to talk to --

9 |           DAVID: Well, get on the ball with that other  
10 | stuff then.

11 |           JIM: Okay. Well, I'm going to see what I --

12 |           DAVID: Here's Steve. I've got to get some  
13 | rest, Jim.

14 |           JIM: Okay. Hey, listen. Hey, listen. Just  
15 | hang in there with me, okay?

16 |           DAVID: All right.

17 |           JIM: Just hang in there, all right? Hey,  
18 | we'll get your message out when this thing's all  
19 | resolved.

20 |           STEVE: Hello, Jim.

21 |           JIM: Hey, Steve?

22 |           STEVE: Yes.

23 |           JIM: Let, let me call you back. I'm trying  
24 | to work on a few things.

25 |           STEVE: Thank you.

          JIM: Okay.

1 STEVE: Thank you. Okay, bye.

2 \* \* \* \* \*

3 STEVE: Hello?

4 JIM: Hey, Steve?

5 STEVE: Yeah.

6 JIM: This is Jim.

7 STEVE: Yes.

8 JIM: How you doing?

9 STEVE: Not bad.

10 JIM: Is David there?

11 STEVE: Yes, he is. David, you want to talk  
12 to Jim? He wants to know what you're doing now?

13 JIM: Well, one thing I wanted to do is I  
14 wanted you to give me the phone number of that line  
15 where you're having the trouble.

16 STEVE: He wanted us to give the phone number  
17 of the line we're having trouble with. Actually, all  
18 of them, 'cause none of them are operating now, except  
19 for one, the one you're talking to me on now. It's the  
20 only one that I can call or you -- and it's only to  
21 you.

22 JIM: Okay. Well, I wanted you to give me  
23 those numbers, but I still need to talk to David, if I  
24 could.

25 STEVE: Okay. The numbers -- pardon?  
(Unidentified voice in background now discernible.)

1 They just said it on TV, that's there only one direct  
2 line open and to you guys.

3 JIM: Oh, really?

4 STEVE: Okay, so, the first number is 863-  
5 5663.

6 JIM: Okay.

7 STEVE: We haven't been using that one. We  
8 didn't -- We don't have it plugged in, so I guess it  
9 doesn't much matter, but --

10 JIM: Okay.

11 STEVE: And bring a phone the next time,  
12 also. And some cord.

13 JIM: Let me see what we can do.

14 STEVE: Okay, 'cause this, this thing is  
15 poor. The other number is a cellular phone, is 744-  
16 2662.

17 JIM: Um-hum.

18 STEVE: And then we have 7 -- or 863-5252.

19 JIM: Okay. All right. All right, I'm going  
20 to give these to the technical guys and --

21 STEVE: And there's one other one, come to  
22 think of it. The other one is -- the one that was cut  
23 off by -- with Wayne was 863 -- and I believe it's --  
24 what's Wayne's number?

25 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Five nine seven  
nine.

1 STEVE: -- 5979.

2 JIM: Okay. Okay, I'll, I'll pass it on to  
3 the technical guys.

4 STEVE: Thank you much, Jim.

5 JIM: But, Steve, I, I --

6 STEVE: We don't even care if you monitor or  
7 whatever else --

8 JIM: Okay.

9 STEVE: -- because, you know, it's to do with  
10 what we believe.

11 JIM: I understand.

12 STEVE: Okay, good.

13 JIM: But can I talk to David?

14 STEVE: Sure. Just a minute.

15 DAVID: Hello?

16 JIM: David.

17 DAVID: Yeah.

18 JIM: Hi. Listen, we've got a change we've  
19 got to talk about.

20 DAVID: All right.

21 JIM: Okay? Now, listen to me before you say  
22 anything, okay? We're having a change in the field  
23 with these tactical commanders, okay?

24 DAVID: Uh-huh.

25 JIM: You know, because all the agents were  
shot and, you know, we're getting a lot of pressure.

1 | We don't want nobody else hurt. We've got the FBI in  
2 | here supporting us and, you know, the state police and  
3 | the National Guard. And you know that, we talked about  
4 | that yesterday.

5 |           DAVID: Yeah.

6 |           JIM: Okay. Now, the tactical commanders are  
7 | going to move the perimeter up.

8 |           DAVID: No, you keep them back.

9 |           JIM: Well, let me, let me, let me tell you  
10 | what -- the reasons and --

11 |           DAVID: I know what the reasons are, Jim.

12 |           JIM: No, David, look --

13 |           DAVID: Okay, you want to kill us, come and  
14 | kill us, Jim.

15 |           JIM: No. Hey, David, no, we're -- this is  
16 | not it. Now, let me tell you why.

17 |           DAVID: Jim, let's stop playing around.

18 |           JIM: No, let me tell you what we did. Let  
19 | me finish. Come on, give me a chance, okay?

20 |           DAVID: They told -- Gary told us all last  
21 | night they weren't around here. All the night vision  
22 | we saw them, we saw them down there digging in. Out by  
23 | the barn, out in the back, there are snipers. They've  
24 | got scopes. I mean, come on.

25 |           JIM: Hey, they're not going to do anything.

          DAVID: Oh, Jim.

1                   JIM: David, they're not. I can walk you out  
2 of there if you want out. And I can -- nobody's going  
3 to do nothing to you.

4                   DAVID: Hey.

5                   JIM: But let me tell you what's going to  
6 happen, okay? We're going to move some of these big  
7 vehicles up to the tactical position, okay? Defensive  
8 only, okay?

9                   DAVID: No.

10                  JIM: One thing that's worrying the  
11 commanders were all those people that were in the bush  
12 and all those people moving around there. They've got  
13 these vehicles that'll protect their men. We made them  
14 take the gun barrels off them. There's no gun barrels  
15 on them, okay? You know, they have a big gun on them.  
16 You guys have a lot of heavy weapons in there and some  
17 of the, you know, the troops want to be protected.

18                  DAVID: So stay back then.

19                  JIM: Well, but they, you know, they've got a  
20 duty that --

21                  DAVID: Look, let's stay back, Jim. Let's  
22 get my kids out and we'll start talking again, all  
23 right?

24                  JIM: David, I'm afraid they're probably  
25 going to be moving before I can stop them.

                  DAVID: Well --



1           JIM: I don't want you to -- I want you to  
2 know they're not coming -- it's strictly they're taking  
3 a position --

4           DAVID: Look, we already discussed -- you  
5 already told me they were going to do nothing until you  
6 gave them the okay. So, like I say --

7           JIM: Well, they're not coming. When I say  
8 that, I mean they're not coming in there.

9           DAVID: But they're moving up closer. They  
10 were coming in close last night. I had to do  
11 everything I could to keep the guys off of them.

12           JIM: Yeah. Nothing is happening except  
13 they're just changing positions and perimeters. They  
14 don't want anybody to be able to come in and bother  
15 you. They don't want anybody to come out, that's the  
16 truth. We don't want anybody to come out unless we  
17 agree. And we have set up -- we're just setting up a  
18 defensive position and nothing progressive, nothing for  
19 attack.

20           DAVID: Who's firing guns?

21           JIM: We're not firing any guns.

22           DAVID: Jim, like I say, I figured eventually  
23 it was going to get to where you all was going to start  
24 cheesing --

25           JIM: No, hey, we're not cheesing.

          DAVID: In your conversation. You're going

1 | to take another inch, another inch.

2 |           JIM: No, listen, I'm trying to tell you this  
3 | in advance as a sign of good faith. I didn't want you  
4 | to think I was tricking you. I'm telling you this is  
5 | going to happen.

6 |           DAVID: Yeah.

7 |           JIM: I'm being straight up. You're not  
8 | going to see the vehicles drive up and say Jim lied.  
9 | I'm telling you they're coming because they feel  
10 | they've got change their, you know, perimeter. And --

11 |           DAVID: They're going to come on our  
12 | property, in other words?

13 |           JIM: Well, I don't -- I'm not sure that's  
14 | going to happen.

15 |           DAVID: Well, get the details and call me  
16 | back.

17 |           JIM: Well, look, I had them take off the gun  
18 | barrels to show you there's no --

19 |           DAVID: Come on, Jim.

20 |           JIM: Huh?

21 |           DAVID: I said come on, Jim. The perimeter  
22 | is our property line, okay? We want these guys off our  
23 | property line.

24 |           JIM: Okay. Well, I'm, you know, I'm going  
25 | to see what I can do. I can't --

          DAVID: If they want to fight, we'll fight.

1 JIM: I can't make that promise, David.

2 DAVID: Okay, they, they want to kill us,  
3 they've got the big guns now.

4 JIM: Nobody wants to kill you.

5 DAVID: Hey --

6 JIM: Nobody wants to kill you.

7 DAVID: Jim --

8 JIM: Trust -- hey, I'm not going to let  
9 them -- nobody's going to kill you. All we're doing is  
10 changing a position. It's going to look like a lot of  
11 activity. They're not coming in there. Nobody's  
12 coming in there.

13 DAVID: Then tell them to stay off our  
14 property.

15 JIM: Okay. Well, just bear with me.

16 DAVID: Or there are going to be some tears.

17 JIM: No, let's not have any trouble. Come  
18 on, you can work with me.

19 DAVID: Yeah, come on, you can work with me,  
20 Jim.

21 JIM: Come on, David.

22 DAVID: We've got a deal going now with the  
23 children getting out.

24 JIM: Yeah.

25 DAVID: Okay? Now, if that don't mean  
anything to you or these hotheads, then we'll have to

1 | deal with that later in the judgment, won't we?

2 |           JIM: No, we want to get the kids out. We  
3 | want to get everybody out. And I don't want anybody to  
4 | get hurt.

5 |           DAVID: Like I said, do what I say then.

6 |           JIM: Not any of your people.

7 |           DAVID: Then do what I say, Jim. Otherwise,  
8 | come on in here and wipe us out.

9 |           JIM: No, that's not going to happen.  
10 | Nobody's coming in there to wipe you out.

11 |           DAVID: Get on the phone and call those guys  
12 | and tell them let's finish up our plan and -- they've  
13 | got plenty of time, you know, to move their tactical  
14 | stuff after the kids are out, you know. You don't need  
15 | to be messing around right now, like a bunch of little  
16 | Boy Scouts.

17 |           JIM: Well, David --

18 |           DAVID: They think they're mature, they think  
19 | they're men. They've got logical thinking. They, they  
20 | think they love the innocent. All right.

21 |           JIM: Well, David, let me ask you, how many  
22 | kids -- you won't tell me and I, I don't know how many  
23 | more --

24 |           DAVID: You're going to find out.

25 |           JIM: Well, I know, but why is that a secret?  
We're just trying to help get them out. And, and, you

1 know, I can't give them a time frame. I mean, what  
2 they're saying is we've got to protect the public from  
3 stray rifle fire, if that would occur, and --

4 DAVID: The, the public's not even out here,  
5 all right?

6 JIM: Well, they're, they're out on that  
7 highway.

8 DAVID: We're way out here.

9 JIM: Yeah, but there, there's a lot of  
10 people on those highways.

11 DAVID: Okay.

12 JIM: Reporters. I'm telling you --

13 DAVID: So what is your time limit that  
14 you're going to come in here and bust --

15 JIM: We're not coming in. We are not coming  
16 in. We are not coming in.

17 DAVID: Well, if you keep getting closer,  
18 we're going to retaliate. And then you're going to  
19 have to come in, and that's just the way it is, Jim.  
20 I'm sorry.

21 JIM: Well, David --

22 DAVID: You're going to keep moving your  
23 erratic finger closer and closer to our rear ends, and  
24 then finally we're going to turn around and we're going  
25 to slug you.

JIM: Yeah.

1 DAVID: I mean, I don't want that to happen.

2 JIM: Yeah.

3 DAVID: You know, I mean, this is a great  
4 nation, but, like I said, it's not bigger than my God.

5 JIM: Yeah.

6 DAVID: Now, the whole meanings of what I'm  
7 trying to tell you in the seals is I'm the little guy  
8 now.

9 JIM: Um-hum.

10 DAVID: Okay, you tried to push me.

11 JIM: I'm not pushing you.

12 DAVID: No, let me, let me say your -- I just  
13 saw Robert Gonzalez on the TV, you know. They tried to  
14 push me. And you did. But, remember, I tried to tell  
15 you about God who judges all nations.

16 JIM: Um-hum.

17 DAVID: I'm the little guy, you're the big  
18 guy.

19 JIM: No, I'm not the big guy.

20 DAVID: You know, the Goliath, I'm the David.  
21 Remember that. Remember, David took five smooth  
22 stones. And we're in the fifth seal now, okay?

23 JIM: Yeah.

24 DAVID: And Goliath does get his head sunken  
25 in with a rock. Think about that.

JIM: Well, listen, David, I, I don't want

1 you to put more into this than is happening.

2 DAVID: Hey --

3 JIM: It's not.

4 DAVID: -- the same, the same, all right?

5 JIM: Okay.

6 DAVID: You tell these guys to back off.

7 We're the ones that are edgy. Really we're not, but,

8 like I say, if they want to keep playing around, then

9 they'll find out what we've got, okay?

10 JIM: Yeah. Listen, okay. I just want you  
11 to relax. Call me if you see them moving.

12 DAVID: You call them and then you call me,  
13 okay? Do what you can, Jim.

14 STEVE: Okay. Let me talk to Steve just a  
15 minute.

16 DAVID: Okay, here.

17 JIM: I want to explain it to him. Steve,  
18 hello?

19 STEVE: Hello?

20 JIM: Steve?

21 STEVE: Yeah.

22 JIM: Hey, this is Jim.

23 STEVE: Okay, Jim.

24 JIM: Listen, now, I've told David and I'm --  
25 I want to tell you, too.

STEVE: All right.

1 JIM: We're going to have a change in the  
2 perimeter. This is -- it's defensive, okay? Now,  
3 you're going to see these vehicles moving and you'll  
4 see where they're set up, okay? Just bear with me now.

5 STEVE: I'm listening.

6 JIM: And once they go to their position and  
7 stop, they're not coming any closer?

8 STEVE: Pardon? I missed the last part.

9 JIM: I, I said they're not coming any  
10 closer. Wherever you see them go and stop, okay?

11 STEVE: They're going to be on the perimeter  
12 of the property?

13 JIM: They're going to -- yeah, they're going  
14 to set up a perimeter out there, okay? And, now, I  
15 told David, these are like big vehicles, three vehicles  
16 that will protect an agent from getting shot, okay?

17 STEVE: And what would an agent be doing near  
18 here anyway?

19 JIM: Well, we're, we're trying to get around  
20 so nobody goes in. You know all the trouble we had  
21 last night with those people in the bushes, you know.

22 STEVE: No, I can't. (Talking to someone  
23 else.)

24 JIM: Steve?

25 STEVE: Yes.

JIM: You know all that stuff we had, people



1 | in the bushes and you guys -- your men saw people and  
2 | our men saw people. And, you know, that's one thing we  
3 | can put an end to. When these things, these vehicles  
4 | move in, it protects us and it protects you. And they  
5 | don't have guns on them.

6 |           STEVE: Jim, I mean, what you're saying, I  
7 | mean, it would sound good to a kindergartner, you know  
8 | that?

9 |           JIM: No. Steve, trust me. We had the guns  
10 | taken off them. They're just so the agents don't get  
11 | shot, that's all. You guys got some heavy stuff in  
12 | there.

13 |           STEVE: We do?

14 |           JIM: Yeah. I mean, you know, assault rifles  
15 | and, I mean, you know, that'd go right through a car.  
16 | I mean, so --

17 |           STEVE: Just a moment. (Unidentified voices  
18 | in background not discernible.) Jim, what part of the  
19 | property?

20 |           JIM: Well, I'm going to -- I have to check  
21 | on that to find out, okay? What I want you to do is  
22 | pass the word, tell everybody they're coming. When  
23 | they stop, that's where they'll stay, okay? They're  
24 | not going to move around. And then when you see them,  
25 | you call me. But they're not coming in.

          STEVE: I don't like this, David. I don't

1 | like it at all.

2 |           JIM: It's, it's only three vehicles.

3 |           STEVE: Well, what is the -- there, there is  
4 | not a good reason, from our perspective, why you're  
5 | doing such a thing at this point of time.

6 |           JIM: Well, it's for your safety --

7 |           STEVE: No, it's not. It's not at all. I  
8 | see -- I don't see that.

9 |           JIM: Well, there's already been too much  
10 | bloodshed, Steve, and --

11 |           STEVE: And you want to cause more.

12 |           JIM: No.

13 |           STEVE: Is that the idea?

14 |           JIM: No.

15 |           STEVE: Well, then why are you bringing such  
16 | things?

17 |           JIM: No, no, we don't --

18 |           STEVE: You see what we're doing? We're  
19 | moving on, aren't we? We keep on moving out, and now  
20 | you want to bring something so close. And what, what  
21 | kind of vehicles are you talking about?

22 |           JIM: Well, we've got -- the reason we're  
23 | doing it is we've got new personnel, we're changing  
24 | shifts. We've got other agents --

25 |           STEVE: You don't, don't -- Jim, you don't  
   | need to tell me why you're doing it. I mean, it's

1 | quite obvious why you're doing it.

2 |           JIM: Well, no. You remember last night when  
3 | you saw all those men moving?

4 |           STEVE: I never did.

5 |           JIM: Well, I know, but your guys did, okay?  
6 | We're putting a stop to that. We're not going to have  
7 | anybody moving like these -- whoever was out there,  
8 | snipers, whatever. We're not going to have that.

9 |           STEVE: I ended up believing you, remember?  
10 | You -- I took a little time each time and then we  
11 | worked it out even then.

12 |           JIM: Right. Remember today when you told me  
13 | those men were at the fence? We're not going to have  
14 | that --

23 STEVE TO UNIDENTIFIED PARTY: What's the  
24 advantage for us to have three of the heavy vehicles  
25 sitting right on the edge of the property? He's trying  
to say it's to our advantage, because that way we won't

1 have people that we see moving around and they won't  
2 either.

3 JIM: Hey, Steve.

4 STEVE: Jim, you know, David's saying get  
5 real.

6 JIM: You'll, you'll be able to see these  
7 things.

8 STEVE: Yeah, we could see a chopper. We  
9 could see what you pulled in the front. I don't care  
10 where it is, when it's that close -- What kind of  
11 vehicles are you talking about?

12 JIM: Well, they're --

13 STEVE: Some kind of armored vehicles?

14 JIM: Yeah. It's what they call an APC.

15 STEVE: APC, total armored vehicle.

16 JIM: You can't shoot a bullet through it.

17 STEVE: I know you can't.

18 JIM: Yeah. That's, that's, that's why we  
19 want to put it there.

20 STEVE: I'm sure, so that you can shoot at us  
21 and --

22 JIM: No.

23 STEVE: -- so forth.

24 JIM: There's no guns on them. We took the  
25 guns off. You can look at them. There's no --

STEVE: How many guys are going to be in each

1 | have their mothers. And I want you, and I want you to  
2 | do is talk to David. Well, we've got to get these two  
3 | guys out right now, these two kids, because the car's  
4 | waiting.

5 |           SITA: Okay.

6 |           JIM: But I want you to think about it and I  
7 | want you to talk to Steve and David about some of the  
8 | mothers coming, and also, you know, some of the kids  
9 | and -- I don't want to rush --

          STEVE: Yeah, she was getting pretty broke up

2 |           SITA: Yeah, she loves those kids, man, I can  
3 | tell. She needs to be with her kids, though.

4 |           STEVE: She knows. She's just concerned  
5 | about some of these others, too. She wants to  
6 | encourage them, that's why, you know, she's talking to

8 |           JIM: Well, I feel like, I feel like Sita  
9 | trusts me, though.

10 |           STEVE: Well, she does.

11 |           JIM: And --

12 |           SITA: You know, she has said that right  
13 | along. She definitely likes you.

14 |           JIM: Yeah. Well, she's been real good. I  
15 | don't know how we would have done it without her or  
16 | you. I mean, you guys have been great. It's just hard  
17 | to work out these things.

18 |           STEVE: You know, we've never been in  
19 | anything like this.

20 |           JIM: But, listen, we have gotten -- This  
21 | is -- the way you're going and the way we're working  
22 | together, we're going to, we're going to resolve it.

23 |           STEVE: Well, you know, we're trying to  
24 | keeping on plugging on. You know, it gets so hard  
25 | because people are getting emotional in here and  
they're, they're scared, you know. A lot of them are



1 | terrified.

2 |           JIM: Yeah. Well, I can understand that.  
3 | And I think you, you know, you may come to a point when  
4 | you all get together with David and you say David, you  
5 | know, we want to go out and we want to go out as a  
6 | group. We are a group. We are --

7 |           STEVE: Some of them here, that's what  
8 | they're talking about wanting to do.

9 |           JIM: Yeah. I mean, we're one people, we  
10 | want to stay together and we want to all come out, you  
11 | know. You'll be saving his life, man, I'm telling you  
12 | you'll be saving his life. I mean, I, I know you love  
13 | him more than anything, between you and me. Between  
14 | you and me, you love the guy. Come on.

15 |           STEVE: Well, you know, I, I like everybody,  
16 | I do. You know, I --

17 |           JIM: Yeah, but you love that guy.

18 |           STEVE: Well, I appreciate him. I have a  
19 | great, you know, I do, I do love the guy a lot.

20 |           JIM: I mean, you love that guy. Come on.

6 |           STEVE: Um-hum.

7 |           JIM: I'm talking about -- I'm not talking  
8 | about the radio station in Dallas. I'm talking about  
9 | some major thing.

10 |           STEVE: Okay.

11 |           JIM: Would you all come out? I mean, would  
12 | you all --

13 |           STEVE: Can I, can I put it to David, because  
14 | that's what he's been talking about?

15 |           JIM: Okay. I mean --

16 |           STEVE: I mean, even tonight -- What is it,  
17 | it's Monday and what about -- Is it a possibility maybe  
18 | of Ted Koppel or something?

19 |           JIM: I mean something, something that would  
20 | be dynamic.

21 |           STEVE: Yeah.

22 |           JIM: I mean, you know, I'm not -- You'd have  
23 | to let us work out the, the details, but --

24 |           STEVE: Right.

25 |           JIM: -- it's just a possibility that --  
Don't put a lot of things on me I can't deliver.

1           STEVE: Yeah, I understand.

2           JIM: You know, Ted Koppel and all these news  
3 stars, you know. You, you leave it to me to get  
4 something that will be acceptable to you, if we can  
5 work it out.

6           STEVE: Uh-huh. Well --

7           JIM: You know, maybe something that's more,  
8 you know, Ted Koppel, you know, I mean, who's watching  
9 that? I mean, I need to watch -- to get it to the  
10 people who are religious.

11          STEVE: Well, let me mention it to him, at  
12 least, here.

13          JIM: Yes. Okay, let's see, did -- Steve?

14          STEVE TO KORESH: He's not promising or  
15 anything, he doesn't know if he can even do it. If  
16 it's possible if he could put you in touch with the,  
17 the best news coverage possible -- I mentioned like the  
18 Ted Koppel --he says would you as a group come out

20          MR. KORESH: Can't do that.

21          STEVE: Well, he's saying he can't do that

8 STEVE: Should I call you back then or are  
9 you going to call me back or --

10 JIM: Tell you what I want to do is just  
11 get --

13 |           STEVE: I mean that's the kind of thing that  
14 | makes some of these people nervous. They don't want to  
15 | be, you know, they're wondering what's going on and  
16 | they're afraid to move. A lot of them are sitting here  
17 | kind of like almost frozen.

18 |           JIM: Yeah, I know, but nobody's coming in.  
19 | You have my word. I know there's perimeter --

20 |           STEVE: Yeah.

21 |           JIM: -- people, Steve. I, I know there is.

22 |           STEVE: What are they doing on the property  
23 | and all that?

24 |           JIM: Yeah, I'm not making a secret of that.  
25 | But I guess we've got to, you know, we've got to kind  
of, like I said earlier, you know, get more toward the

1 | brass tacks, and that is --

2 |           STEVE: Well, that's what we want to do, but,  
3 | you know, I mean, you did tell us, you know, that they

21 |           JIM: I know. Look, here's what --

22 |           STEVE: Okay.

23 |           JIM: Here's what we're going to have to do.

24 |           STEVE: All right.

25 |           JIM: As soon as we get these kids hooked up,  
I'm going to go back and talk to these commanders --

1 STEVE: All right. Okay.

2 JIM: -- about that perimeter motion, okay?

3 STEVE: Right.

4 JIM: And, and some of these issues we've  
5 discussed.

6 STEVE: Right, okay.

7 JIM: I've got to round them up. There's a  
8 bunch of them in here.

9 STEVE: Okay.

10 JIM: And --

11 STEVE: And call me back then?

12 JIM: No, because I want to hook these kids  
13 up, okay? And, and, and, and David said that he wanted  
14 to keep the kids coming out.

15 STEVE: Right.

16 JIM: And you've got these other two, Chrissy  
17 and -- You've got Brian and Jake are coming out and  
18 you've got Chrissy and Scott.

19 STEVE: Yeah.

20 JIM: So what, what I want you to do, I've  
21 got Henry here, okay?

22 STEVE: Okay.

23 JIM: He's been with me all through this.

24 STEVE: All right.

25 JIM: Okay? Helping me, setting up the car,  
doing everything, okay?

1 STEVE: Yeah.

2 JIM: He's personal with me. I know the guy,  
3 he's golden, okay? We've worked every -- Everything  
4 we've worked out stands.

5 STEVE: Okay.

6 JIM: Okay, he's not going to make any  
7 changes to the, you know, he's going to try to work  
8 with you. He knows all the agreements, he sat and went  
9 through everything.

10 STEVE: Okay.

11 JIM: Okay?

12 STEVE: Yeah.

13 JIM: And he, he really is a good fellow,  
14 okay? And I want you to just talk with him on the  
15 mechanics of getting Chrissy and Scott out, okay? And  
16 then, and then, you know, just to continue with it,  
17 okay?

18 STEVE: Yeah.

19 JIM: While I go try to work on these  
20 commanders. As long as we're doing this, I mean, it's  
21 positive.

22 STEVE: Okay.

23 JIM: Okay?

24 STEVE: Is it okay if I get off the phone  
25 here and talk with them then?

JIM: Okay, wait. There's a vehicle

1 approaching.

2 STEVE: Okay.

3 JIM: You know --

4 STEVE: I tell you, I'm so weak I'm standing  
5 here and --

6 JIM: Just hang with me one second, Steve.

7 STEVE: Okay.

8 JIM: Listen --

9 STEVE: I'm tired.

10 JIM: -- what I want you -- After, after you  
11 talk to Henry a while, and he'll give you a break, but,  
12 you know, David can convince everyone to come out if he  
13 has a mind to.

14 STEVE: Well, you know, that's what he's been  
15 saying to them. He again said to these people, he said  
16 look, you know, he's already told them. And like right  
17 now he's laying back because he's, he is, you know, I'm  
18 telling you he can hardly talk.

19 JIM: Yeah.

20 STEVE: He mustered up what he could to talk  
21 with you, but he is tired.

22 JIM: Well, you, you've got to work with him,  
23 you've got to --

24 STEVE: Well, that's what I need to do now.  
25 That's what I wanted to do.

JIM: Okay. Let me just tell you we've got

1 | the kids --

2 |           STEVE: Okay.

3 |           JIM: -- and then you can work out with Henry  
4 | just a time to, you know, to keep bringing people out  
5 | and, you know, the kids anyway. Trust me, Steve, Henry  
6 | won't let you down now. I wouldn't give you anybody  
7 | that you couldn't trust.

8 |           STEVE: Right.

9 |           JIM: I mean, the guy's first-rate, okay?

10 |          STEVE: Okay.

11 |          JIM: Everything he says right down the line,  
12 | okay? Okay, the cars are there.

13 |          STEVE: Okay.

14 |          JIM: The commanders are telling me the cars  
15 | are there. You okay?

16 |          STEVE: Yeah. Oh, I'm getting tired. There,  
17 | there, you know, there's people all over the place here  
18 | and --

19 |          JIM: You know -- Okay, the kids are out?  
20 | You know, you guys talk about it. Nobody's coming in  
21 | there.

22 |          STEVE: Okay.

23 |          JIM: You've got my word, it's solid, it's  
24 | 1,000 percent absolute, okay?

25 |          STEVE: Okay.

          JIM: I know, I know that everybody's

1 | skittish, but, you know, we've just got to work on the  
2 | kids and we've got to let -- What are they saying on  
3 | the radio, 10 kids?

4 |           STEVE: Yeah. Wait. (Indiscernible voice in  
5 | background) David, he believes that you're fixing to  
6 | hit us tonight, he says.

7 |           JIM: No, we are not fixing to hit you. That  
8 | is not true.

9 |           STEVE: I mean, here's, here's this crazy  
10 | radio again, you know. I mean, where, where are they  
11 | getting that information?

12 |           JIM: You know, that is baloney. It's  
13 | rubbish.

14 |           STEVE: The news media was told to get out of  
15 | the way and to back way off, much farther back than  
16 | what they are even now. Why is that?

17 |           JIM: Nobody's coming in there. A thousand  
18 | percent absolute guarantee. I'm promising you, it's  
19 | true, okay? Do we got those kids? Okay. Steve?

20 |           STEVE: Yeah.

21 |           JIM: Let me check here. Hold on a second.

22 |           STEVE: These guys are being told to move  
23 | back a half-mile more even for safety. Safety of what?

24 |           JIM: Okay. I'm sorry, for what?

25 |           STEVE: We're listening -- Right now on the  
news all the press is, is being told to move back a

1 | half-mile more for their own safety. What are they  
2 | talking about?

3 |           JIM: Yeah. Oh, well, what they're doing is  
4 | they don't want them in any of the -- They've been  
5 | crawling down our backs, all those reporters. Crawling  
6 | down our backs.

7 |           STEVE: Well, their comments are, you know,  
8 | for safety, that they don't get hurt and so forth. I  
9 | mean, wow.

10 |           JIM: Oh, yeah, but that's not -- That's  
11 | normal. We don't want them there. I mean, they've  
12 | raced in real fast early and, you know, now we're just  
13 | trying to get them back and clear the road. It's

17 |           STEVE: I suppose.

18 |           JIM: And the policemen are just glad, you  
19 | know, you go out and the lieutenant says get rid of all  
20 | the reporters. What do you think the policeman does?  
21 | Tries to kick their butt back a mile, so don't -- it's  
22 | no big thing. Okay, look --

23 |           STEVE: Yeah.

24 |           JIM: -- I've got -- Hold on.

25 |           UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: We've got the  
kids. They're on their way back. We have another car



1 in to pick up two more.

2 JIM: Okay, we've got the kids.

3 STEVE: Okay.

4 JIM: They're safe.

5 STEVE: Okay.

6 JIM: They're on the way back here.

7 STEVE: Can you -- Can I get off the phone  
8 and then have them call again? And we're working on

24 JIM: Okay, I'm sorry. Okay, I'll tell you  
25 what, let's --

STEVE: Okay.

1 JIM: -- can we take, take a break?

2 STEVE: Oh, thanks.

3 JIM: Can you --

4 STEVE: I'm going to actually kind of lay  
5 down here --

6 JIM: Okay.

7 STEVE: -- in just a minute.

8 JIM: Take a break. Can you call me here?

9 STEVE: Yeah. Well, so far, I haven't been  
10 able to. I tried to call you about 10 minutes ago and  
11 I'm still not able to get out.

12 JIM: Okay.

13 STEVE: What do you think? Is it -- Do you  
14 think --

15 JIM: All right, hold on, let me check on it.

16 STEVE: All right.

17 JIM: Okay.

18 STEVE: When, when should I call you?

19 JIM: Have you got that set up? (Talking to  
20 someone else.) Okay, listen, Steve --

21 STEVE: Yeah.

22 JIM: -- you pick up the phone --

23 STEVE: Right.

24 JIM: -- and I'm going to have the technician  
25 set it to ring my number.

STEVE: Okay. You mean like right now, just

1 | to try it?  
2 |           JIM: You want to try it right now?  
3 |           STEVE: If you want.  
4 |           JIM: Yeah.  
5 |           STEVE: I mean, would that be the thing or --  
6 |           JIM: Yeah. Let's hang up, hang up.  
7 |           STEVE: Okay.  
8 |           JIM: Just leave it hang up for 15 seconds.  
9 |           STEVE: All right.  
10 |           JIM: And then pick it up and see if you get  
11 | me.  
12 |           STEVE: Okay, I'll try.  
13 |                           \* \* \* \* \*  
14 |           STEVE: Hello?  
15 |           HENRY: Steve?  
16 |           STEVE: Yeah.  
17 |           HENRY: This is Henry.  
18 |           STEVE: Henry?  
19 |           HENRY: Yeah.  
20 |           STEVE: Oh, okay. Henry, it's not working.  
21 |           HENRY: Did you dial?  
22 |           STEVE: Yeah, I did.  
23 |           HENRY: Don't dial. Just pick it up and --  
24 |           STEVE: Oh, I see.  
25 |           HENRY: -- just hold it.  
          STEVE: Just -- Okay.

1 HENRY: You don't have to dial at all, just  
2 pick it up and just hold it.

3 STEVE: I see. Okay, let me try to -- Can I  
4 try it again?

5 HENRY: Sure.

6 STEVE: Okay, thanks. I'll call you back.

7 \* \* \* \* \*

8 STEVE: Hello?

9 HENRY: Hello, Steve?

10 STEVE: Yes.

11 HENRY: This is Henry.

12 STEVE: Henry, how are you doing?

13 HENRY: Good. How are you doing?

14 STEVE: Well, I tried to call you back but I  
15 guess it didn't work.

16 HENRY: Okay. We have the kids here, but  
17 just before we get to the kids, we have the APC's that  
18 are going to be moving in.

19 STEVE: The, the which?

20 HENRY: The carriers that are moving into the  
21 general perimeter of the area. Remember, we talked  
22 about that earlier?

23 STEVE: Aren't there already three here or  
24 something?

25 HENRY: Well, those, those are the ones that  
we talked about, but they have never been -- they have

1 never moved into position. They're going to be moving  
2 into position now. I want to let you know that so  
3 that --

4 STEVE: Okay.

5 HENRY: Okay?

6 STEVE: Yeah. They're moving three -- What  
7 are they called?

8 HENRY: APC's.

9 STEVE: -- APC's into position now that they  
10 had mentioned, which they hadn't done yet. (Talking to  
11 someone else.)

12 HENRY: But they have no -- Yeah, they don't  
13 have the, they don't have the capability to shoot.

14 STEVE: Okay.

15 HENRY: Okay?

16 STEVE: Okay.

17 HENRY: The, the cannon and the muzzles were  
18 removed, so everything should be fine.

19 STEVE: Okay. (Unidentified voice in  
20 background not discernible.)

21 HENRY: Okay, and we have the kids --

22 STEVE: It's not Jim. Henry, what happened  
23 to Jim then?

24 HENRY: He is working on -- I'm not sure  
25 exactly what he's working on. He's working with the,  
with the -- some of our brass on working out some of

1 | the details. What we'd like to try to do is we'd like  
2 | to try to continue bringing kids out and any other  
3 | people that are ready to come out.

4 |           STEVE TO UNIDENTIFIED PARTY: Okay. So  
5 | they'd like to continue bringing the kids out and any  
6 | others that want to come out. He's talking to the  
7 | brass, I don't know about what. (Unidentified voice in  
8 | background not discernible.)

9 |           STEVE: He wants Jim to give him a call as  
10 | soon as the van is here, I guess.

11 |           HENRY: Okay. Is Jake -- I have Jake here,  
12 | or Jacob.

13 |           STEVE: Okay.

14 |           HENRY: Who would Jacob be talking to?

15 |           STEVE: Who would Jake be talking to? He has  
16 | Jake there, of course, and little Brian. (Unidentified  
17 | female voice in background not discernible.)

18 |           [gap]

19 |           UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Jake?

20 |           HENRY: This is Henry. Who is this?

21 |           UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Can I have  
22 | Jake, please?

23 |           HENRY: Yes, you certainly may. Hold on just  
24 | a second.

25 |           JAKE: Hi.

          UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Hi. I love

1 you. I love you. Tell Brian, okay? Tell Brian I love  
2 him, okay? I've got to go. Put the other guy back on  
3 the phone. I love you. Tell me, tell me you love me.

4 JAKE: Bye.

5 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Bye.

6 HENRY: Hello?

7 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Put the guy  
8 back on the phone.

9 HENRY: Huh?

10 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Okay.

11 HENRY: Hello?

12 [gap]

13 HENRY: Hello?

14 [gap]

15 HENRY: Hello?

16 STEVE: Henry?

17 HENRY: Yes.

18 STEVE: So is Jim getting back on the phone  
19 then or --

20 HENRY: Well, not just now. He's, you know,  
21 he's talking to, to some of our --

22 STEVE: Well, can you have him call back as  
23 soon as he's ready then, because the next two --

24 HENRY: We're ready now. If you're ready to,  
25 to send two other people now, I'll, I'll work those  
arrangements right now.

1 STEVE: Well, that's what David is hoping,  
2 that, you know, to try --

3 HENRY: Okay, that's fine. We'll work it  
4 right now.

5 STEVE: All right.

6 HENRY: Are you, are you ready to send them  
7 right now?

8 STEVE: Well, he mentioned -- What, did you  
9 want to talk to Jim about the next two that you have  
10 or -- Yeah, he says him and Jim's got the deal going  
11 and he wants to keep on talking with Jim, I guess.

12 HENRY: Well, I'd like to -- Can I talk to  
13 him for just a second?

14 STEVE: Okay. He wants to talk to you.

15 MR. KORESH: Hello?

16 HENRY: How are you doing?

17 MR. KORESH: Kind of weak. How are you boys  
18 doing.

19 HENRY: How do you feel now?

20 MR. KORESH: How do I feel now?

21 HENRY: Um-hum.

22 MR. KORESH: Just a little pain.

23 HENRY: Okay. What we'd like to do, David,  
24 is we'd like to continue working as we were before.  
25 We'd like to continue bringing out additional children,  
as best as we can, with the same agreement that we had



1 before. And we'd like to work, if possible, you know,  
2 everybody has a concern here about you. We feel that,  
3 you know, that you're not really taking care of  
4 yourself. We don't want anything to happen to you.  
5 We'd like for you to consider coming out yourself.

6 We want everybody to come out, we want  
7 everybody to come out of this alive. We don't want you  
8 to give up, and we feel that you are. That's a great  
9 concern to, to all of us.

10 MR. KORESH: Well, like I was telling Jim,  
11 you know, I told Jim to, to look into that Bible. I  
12 told him to look into Revelation 4 and 5. I told him  
13 to look into those seals. Now, if you look at the, the  
14 fifth seal, if you look at the sixth seal, if you look  
15 into Isaiah 13, if you look in Joel 2, if you look into  
16 the back of Nahum, what's fixing to happen has already  
17 been foretold. I teach seven seals.

18 Now, whatever that means, you know, I'd like  
19 to talk with you guys in full. I'd like you to grab a  
20 Bible, sit down and follow me word by word, see what  
21 the ancients have foresaw. And that way we'd have a  
22 better understanding. But I realize that, you know,  
23 most of you are not ready for that. You've got your  
24 own way of doing things.

25 HENRY: Well, one of the concerns that we  
have, you know, that I feel that you may have is you

1 | mentioned earlier that you felt that people were  
2 | calling you a cult leader, okay? If you give up, that  
3 | may in fact be the impression that everybody has,  
4 | whereas if you continue to fight in terms of trying to  
5 | save your life and continue to lead your people, that's  
6 | not the impression that will be created.

7 | MR. KORESH: Look --

8 | HENRY: You've been a family person, okay?  
9 | And your family --

10 | MR. KORESH: Oh, I'm definitely a family  
11 | person.

12 | HENRY: And your family needs you. And  
13 | everybody wants to see you come out of this alive.

14 | MR. KORESH: Look, Henry --

15 | HENRY: Everybody needs you. These people  
16 | need you, the kids need you.

17 | MR. KORESH: You're not going to listen to  
18 | me, are you?

19 | HENRY: I will listen to you.

20 | MR. KORESH: Okay, you're listening now?

21 | HENRY: Yes, I am.

22 | MR. KORESH: Okay. The event that you're now  
23 | fixing to witness is you're fixing to see a government,  
24 | a government that's been blessed -- See, there was an  
25 | ancient empire called Babylon.

HENRY: Um-hum.

1 MR. KORESH: Land of the Chaldeans. And  
2 before Babylon ruled the then-known world, God had a  
3 people that he brought out of Egypt and God had given  
4 them laws and statutes and God had stated unto Israel,  
5 which was a cult because they had one leader, Moses,  
6 and one right-hand man, Aaron, and God says and  
7 promised that if they will keep his laws he'll make  
8 them the head of all nations. If they break his laws,  
9 he'll scatter them amongst the nations and the nations  
10 of the heathens will rule over them.

11 So for many, many hundreds of years God  
12 forebores his people. But, finally, the days came when  
13 Israel became worse than the heathens. So God arose  
14 prophets such as Isaiah, Hosea, Obadiah, Malachi,  
15 Zephaniah, Habakkuk, you know, these prophets, Nahum.  
16 And God foretold in these prophets how that they'd be  
17 scattered amongst the nations. In the Book of Daniel,  
18 Daniel was shown, while under the Chaldean captivity,  
19 he was shown that the nations of the earth that shall  
20 rule over God's people will be symbolized as one great  
21 image, and the image will be head of gold, arms of  
22 silver, belly of brass, legs of iron, feet part of iron  
23 and part of clay.

24 And Daniel says to the king, Nebuchadnezzar,  
25 the highest ruling position of the land in that day,  
Daniel says thou oh, King, of this head of gold, and

1 after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to  
2 thee, and yet a third kingdom of brass. And then a  
3 fourth kingdom, dreadful and terrible, it shall cometh  
4 the whole world.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 MR. KORESH: And then there shall be a  
7 kingdom that shall be at the ten toes, partly strong  
8 and partly broken. So when Rome split up under the  
9 nomadic kingdoms, it fell into many different kingdoms.

10 HENRY: Um-hum.

11 MR. KORESH: We know it as Europe. Now,  
12 Daniel goes on to explain that while Europe is still in  
13 existence, he goes on to say (indiscernible) behold a  
14 stone, came and smote the image in the feet and they  
15 had gold and silver and brass and iron, was all made as  
16 the chaff of the summer threshing floors. Well, this  
17 stone is the subject of which the Book of Revelation  
18 talks about. It talks about that which must be  
19 hereafter, that God will one day in the future, in the  
20 end of the world, shall come and sit on his throne in  
21 heaven, and there'll be one question asked in heaven.

22 The question is who is worthy to open this  
23 book? The book is in the right hand of God. And to  
24 lose these seven seals thereof, scripture clearly  
25 teaches Christendom, that no man in heaven nor on earth  
neither under earth was able to open and he looked

1 thereon.

2 HENRY: Um-hum.

3 MR. KORESH: But the lamb, the lamb is  
4 symbolized as a lamb with seven eyes and seven horns.  
5 You know, God creates things in seven days, doesn't he?

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 MR. KORESH: Okay. There's only one many who  
8 knows what that book teaches. But for the sake of  
9 humanity, the acid test revolving around the subjects  
10 in this book revolve around Christ in heaven, opening  
11 the seals, and what is witnessed is a man on a white  
12 horse, a man on a red horse, black and pale. Dead  
13 souls under the altar described to God because of their  
14 blood that's been shed, and then the time when the sun  
15 and moon and stars will be darkened, the heavens will  
16 part as a scroll and the great man, mighty men, free  
17 men, bonded men shall cry to the rocks and mountains to  
18 fall on them and hide them from the face of him that  
19 sits on the throne and from the wrath of the lamb, but  
20 the great David's wrath has come.

21 HENRY: Um-hum.

22 MR. KORESH: So these subjects are mysteries,  
23 'cause nobody really has a real thorough opinion to  
24 really know the real meanings of these things. But in  
25 Chapter 10, after the student of scripture is read and  
become familiar with the symbols, in Chapter 10, after

1 | talking about an army of 200 million that overthrow the  
2 | world, it talks about a mighty angel coming down from  
3 | heaven. And he has in his hand a little book and it's  
4 | opened and seven thunders are uttered, seven thunders.  
5 | And John was told that when there's time no longer this  
6 | mystery of God, this revelation of Jesus Christ, the  
7 | seven seals will be finished, as God has declared to  
8 | his servants the prophets.

9 |           HENRY: Um-hum.

10 |           MR. KORESH: So in this 22nd chapter, after a  
11 | person takes the time to read these things, it's very  
12 | clear, the statement, Christ says I Jesus have sent my  
13 | angel to testify to these things in the churches. I am  
14 | the root and the offspring of David. Now, Ancient  
15 | David was a great king, wasn't he?

16 |           HENRY: Um-hum.

17 |           MR. KORESH: He's the one that took his  
18 | little sling stone and slew the great giant Goliath.

19 |           HENRY: Right.

20 |           MR. KORESH: Yeah, okay. So what happened  
21 | was he says behold, I come quickly. My reward is with  
22 | me, to give it to every man according as his work shall  
23 | be.

24 |           HENRY: Um-hum.

25 |           MR. KORESH: Now, when Christ comes, the  
question is going to be what did the father give him

1 | that no other man in heaven was worthy to receive? No  
2 | man was worthy. A book, right?

3 |           HENRY: Um-hum.

4 |           MR. KORESH: God gave him a book, a  
5 | revelation of himself that the father claims he's the  
6 | author of this book. And when the lamb comes, he's  
7 | going to bring this book and mankind is supposed to  
8 | find out that it is the Bible, the Bible which the  
9 | prophets of God having spoken by the spirit that God  
10 | gave them, having volumed a testament in regards to  
11 | those events that must be fulfilled in the latter days.  
12 | Now, in Revelation 13, John witnesses in regards to the  
13 | seventh seal, John sees a beast.

14 |           This beast has a head like a lion, a body  
15 | like a leopard, feet of a bear. In Daniel 7, Daniel  
16 | foretold that the empires of Babylon -- Persia, Greece  
17 | and Rome would be symbolized, Babylon as a lion, --  
18 | Persia as a bear, Greece as a leopard. And the fourth  
19 | beast, he said, would devour all the three beasts  
20 | before it and conquer the world. Now, that was Rome.  
21 | Daniel also says in the days of this kingdom they will  
22 | kill the prince of the covenant. They could change  
23 | God's times and God's laws and place abomination to  
24 | make desolate false religion. We know the only true  
25 | religion is the religion of God.

          HENRY: Um-hum.

1 MR. KORESH: Now, Christ died during the  
2 times of Rome and on the cross. Very clearly, it's  
3 written in the gospel records. He said father, forgive  
4 them for they know not what they do.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 MR. KORESH: And then he said into thy hand I  
7 commit my spirit. And the hand of God has a book, the  
8 word. By the word of God, God made heaven and earth.  
9 And by his word, there was prophets. The events that  
10 you're now witnessing are taking place. Now, what is  
11 taking place? Well, in the Book of Micah, it says in  
12 that day they shall gather together and they shall say  
13 let thine be defiled that they know not the thoughts of  
14 the Lord, neither do they understand his counsel.

15 All of the prophets through the Book of  
16 Nahum, it talks about Messiah, it talks about, well,  
17 for instance, to make it real simple, Christ says he  
18 has the key of David in revelation. So in the Book of  
19 the Psalms, for instance Psalms 2, David sees a vision  
20 of the future, of a confrontation between man and man's  
21 law --

22 HENRY: Um-hum.

23 MR. KORESH: -- and God and God's law.

24 HENRY: Um-hum.

25 MR. KORESH: Now, Revelation 13 tells us that  
there's a lamb-like beast that'll rise up, having two



1 | horns, and it'll speak as a dragon. Now, we've got to  
2 | identify what great empire arose up after Europe that's  
3 | a great empire that's lamb-like or Christian, but yet  
4 | doesn't really tell the truth. Well, the only great  
5 | empire we've known is the United States of America.  
6 | Now, back to Psalms 2, the psalm says why do the  
7 | heathen rage? You know, the heathen don't know God.

8 |           HENRY: Um-hum.

9 |           MR. KORESH: They don't know his word.

10 |          HENRY: Um-hum.

11 |          MR. KORESH: And they get angry.

12 |          HENRY: Um-hum.

13 |          MR. KORESH: It says, and the people imagine  
14 | vain things, for the leaders of the earth and the  
15 | rulers take counsel together against the Lord --

16 |          HENRY: Um-hum.

17 |          MR. KORESH: -- and against his anointed.

18 |          HENRY: Um-hum.

19 |          MR. KORESH: That's Christ, you see?

20 |          HENRY: Um-hum.

21 |          MR. KORESH: Saying let us break his bands  
22 | asunder. Now, what are the seven bands that Christ  
23 | promises to bring when he comes again? The seven  
24 | seals, right?

25 |          HENRY: Um-hum.

          MR. KORESH: But Zachariah and the other

1 | prophets say that the world will not regard these  
2 | messages of mercy. They have no interest in being  
3 | instructed by anyone but themselves. Now, they say let  
4 | us break his bands asunder, let us cast his cords away  
5 | from us. But scripture says, which is taking place  
6 | right now, it says that he that sits in the heavens --  
7 | That's the father, you see?

8 |           HENRY: Um-hum.

9 |           MR. KORESH: -- shall laugh, for the Lord  
10 | shall have them, the heathen, in confusion. See, the  
11 | heathen don't know what they're doing. And this time  
12 | they can't be forgiven because this time they willfully  
13 | reject the subject which so plainly has been laid in  
14 | the Book of Revelation, a subject which everyone is to  
15 | be very familiarized with for the latter days. And  
16 | yet, they're to understand by earnest study that these  
17 | things will remain a mystery until Christ comes again.

18 |           HENRY: Um-hum.

19 |           MR. KORESH: To reveal these mysteries.

20 |           HENRY: Um-hum.

21 |           MR. KORESH: So the heathen and their tactics  
22 | in dealing with a person based upon rumors and based  
23 | upon their laws, they fail to understand that God also  
24 | has a law and God also has a kingdom and God also has a  
25 | key. So what takes place, it says, then shall the Lord  
   | speak unto them in his wrath. That's what happens

1 | during the sixth seal.

2 |           HENRY: Um-hum.

3 |           MR. KORESH: The sun and moon and stars is  
4 | darkened, the heaven departs as a scroll, and the great  
5 | men of the earth cry to the rocks and mountains to hide  
6 | them from the face of the reality that they would not  
7 | know aforetime what God said will be. So they end up  
8 | fulfilling prophecy, not knowing what side they're  
9 | doing. But to the wise, when God speaks in his wrath,  
10 | they already know of the events. And it says yet have  
11 | I set my king up on my holy hill of Zion.

12 |           So irrespective of what attitude the heathen  
13 | may take against the truth of the seven seals or the  
14 | man that is trying to teach the seven seals,  
15 | irrespective, God's kingdom, the stone, God himself is  
16 | going to intervene and he's going to hit the image in  
17 | the feet and it's all going to blow away, and God's  
18 | going to take the jurisdiction and power from all the  
19 | great men of the earth and all that the prophets have  
20 | spoken is to be fulfilled.

21 |           HENRY: Um-hum.

22 |           MR. KORESH: Now, the psalm continues to say  
23 | I will declare the decree, the Lord has said unto me,  
24 | thou art my son, this day have I begotten thee. So we  
25 | know the anointed one is Christ, don't we? Christ is  
the Son of God in Psalms 2, right?

1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 MR. KORESH: And it says the father says to  
3 the son ask of me and I will give thee the heathen for  
4 thine inheritance and the other most parts of the earth  
5 for thy possession, for thou shalt dash the heathen to  
6 pieces with a rod of iron and shall break them as a  
7 potter's vessel. Now, that's pretty bad, isn't it?

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 MR. KORESH: I mean, nobody wants to be hurt,  
10 do they?

11 HENRY: No, really.

12 MR. KORESH: So that's why in Psalms 2 the  
13 subject is clear, the mission of the lamb, the anointed  
14 one, is to teach the seals, okay?

15 HENRY: Um-hum.

16 MR. KORESH: Now, the reason why the prophecy  
17 is written is because it continues to say now,  
18 therefore, be wise, ye rulers of the world, be  
19 instructed, ye judges of the earth. Serve the Lord  
20 with fear and rejoice with trembling. Kiss the son,  
21 least he be angry, and ye perish in the way when his  
22 wrath is kindled but a little. Now, I'm not mad at you  
23 guys, you know.

24 HENRY: Well, and we're not mad at you,  
25 either.

MR. KORESH: Well, but your show of arms is

1 definitely bigger than my show of arms. So in Psalms  
2 18, the psalm has made very plain when it says I will  
3 love the Lord for he is my rock and my salvation, my  
4 buckler and the horn of my salvation. It says I will  
5 call upon him so shall I be delivered from my enemies,  
6 for they were too strong for me. And the day of my  
7 calamity, and this is a calamity, really, they  
8 prevented me. And then it goes on to talk about a  
9 terrible event that takes place afterwards, because,  
10 you know, you all guys are too big for me.

11                   You know, your laws are more numerous than  
12 the Ten Commandments, you know, your weapons are  
13 bigger, your forces are stronger.

14                   HENRY: Um-hum.

15                   MR. KORESH: You know? But not really. You  
16 see, not really. You know, Elijah in his day, the king  
17 of Israel was having to face the Moabites and the  
18 Hittites and they were outnumbered. But what Elijah  
19 said was they that be with us are more than they that  
20 be with them because unbeknown to the forces of the  
21 heathen who were so boistering of their superior power  
22 they did not see the invisible forces of God, the  
23 angels of God, you know, just like in the days of  
24 ancient Hezekiah.

25                   HENRY: Um-hum.

                  MR. KORESH: When the Assyrian armies came

1 | wouldn't he?

2 |           DAVID: Yeah. I can't get down there to it  
3 | so. Yeah, that's what we'll do.

4 |           HENRY: Okay. And you know how everybody's  
5 | concerned about money. And I mean everybody is, has a  
6 | concern. Can you do me a favor, and can you make it,  
7 | you know, like in such a fashion that, that in order to  
8 | avoid their wanting to chop it up or to play part of it  
9 | or whatever --

10 |           DAVID: How much, how much does it cost their  
11 | air time?

12 |           HENRY: Well, that's the whole thing.

13 |           DAVID: Per minute?

14 |           HENRY: That's the whole thing. You know, so  
15 | keep --

16 |           DAVID: How much does it cost?

17 |           HENRY: I don't have any idea. But  
18 | there's --

19 |           DAVID: Give me the price and I'll pay it.

20 |           HENRY: Oh, I don't have any idea. I have no  
21 | idea. But what I'd like to do is I would like for you  
22 | to make it as concise and as brief as you can make it  
23 | so that we can be in a situation where your word will,  
24 | will get out. Nothing will be chopped off. Your  
25 | message will go out as you want it, you know.

          DAVID: Well, like I say remember I'll even

1 | buy the time. You know?

2 |           HENRY: Well, you know, we don't need --

3 |           DAVID: We will fund it.

4 |           HENRY: -- we don't need that. We -- what we  
5 | want is we want you to -- you were given your  
6 | cooperation, and that's what we promised what we would  
7 | do. So I want to live up to my part of it. Yeah, I  
8 | don't need your money. But I do need --

9 |           (Touch tone sounds.)

10 |           DAVID: Hello? Hello?

11 |           HENRY: Jesus.

12 |           DAVID: Hello?

13 |           HENRY: Hello.

14 |           DAVID: Hello. What's going on now?

15 |           HENRY: Who was that?

16 |           DAVID: Yeah. (Unidentified voice in  
17 | background not discernible.)

18 |           HENRY: What -- you know, what I, what I  
19 | would like to see is I would like for you to, to  
20 | prepare yourself in such a fashion that you get your  
21 | message out and --

22 |           DAVID: Okay, wait a second.

23 |           HENRY: Now, I'm a little bit confused about  
24 | one thing. Okay? I, I know that you're, that you are  
25 | a man of your word number one. And number two, I know  
that you know what you're talking about in terms of

1 | theology. I'm not as -- I'm not nearly versed as you  
2 | are, okay? But one of the concerns that I have is I am  
3 | taking you to your word and that is that you're going  
4 | to come out and that everybody is going to come out and  
5 | this thing is going to be resolved without anybody --

6 |           DAVID: Getting hurt.

7 |           HENRY: Getting hurt. That includes you.

8 |           DAVID: Except for what crimes we have to pay  
9 | for what we've committed that is that. The world so  
10 | speaks.

11 |           HENRY: And that includes you. Am I correct  
12 | in assuming that --

13 |           DAVID: No, it's not an assumption. It's a  
14 | fact.

15 |           HENRY: Okay. Everybody's going to come out,  
16 | and everybody's going to be fine, and there's going to  
17 | be no shooting, and there's going to be nothing to, to  
18 | cause anybody to do anything to hurt you. I don't want  
19 | anybody to hurt you. Am I, am I correct in my  
20 | assumption?

21 |           DAVID: You're correct on that.

22 |           HENRY: Okay.

23 |           DAVID: So let's, let -- I got to start  
24 | editing this and, and you got the van down there for  
25 | the children, right?

          HENRY: Yes.



1           DAVID: Okay. Be sure and tell them we're  
2 coming then, all right?

3           HENRY: Okay. Now, now listen, listen to  
4 what I'm going to tell you. I don't know if this van  
5 is going to stop in exactly the same place as the other  
6 van. It's going to be real close. The only reason  
7 that I'm telling you that is whoever's going to take  
8 the kids there, you know, these are two new people,  
9 because we've had a changing of a shift, okay? So --

10          DAVID: Okay. But just at the water  
11 towers --

12          HENRY: Right. Right.

13          DAVID: -- like it was before.

14          HENRY: But, but I mean, you know, they may  
15 be 20 feet back or, or 5 feet forward from where they  
16 parked before. I don't want her to get a concern,  
17 whoever it is that's taking them there well, it's, they  
18 didn't park in exactly the same place. Nothing's --

19          DAVID: Okay.

20          HENRY: -- going to happen other than what  
21 has happened before.

22          DAVID: You got a radio communication, right?

23          HENRY: Right.

24          DAVID: Okay. Like I say, we'll get the kids  
25 ready and --

          HENRY: Right.

1 DAVID: Are they down there now?

2 HENRY: Yes. Now what, what we're going to  
3 need is I would like to try to start trying to find you  
4 medical help.

5 DAVID: No, not yet.

6 HENRY: Okay.

7 DAVID: Let's get the other done.

8 HENRY: Yes, we'll get -- no, I mean that's  
9 fine. And I understand that. And I'm not saying, you  
10 know, I'm going to send anybody in there. I want start  
11 preparing to have something ready for you after you do  
12 your tape and all of that. Okay?

13 DAVID: Okie doke.

14 HENRY: Okay.

15 DAVID: Okay. Now I need to -- going to send  
16 the kids.

17 HENRY: Okay.

18 DAVID: He's going to get the equipment set  
19 up.

20 HENRY: Okay.

21 DAVID: I'm going to drink a little orange  
22 juice, get my breath up a bit. When I, when I cough,  
23 oh, man. I'll tell you. Anyway never mind.

24 HENRY: How much time do you think you have?

25 DAVID: Well, see it's, it's like I get, I  
get renewed.

1 HENRY: Uh-huh.

2 DAVID: You know, and then, you know, the  
3 pain and all of a sudden I get where it's like  
4 something's developing in my chest. It's like -- I  
5 don't know. It's, it's kind of like a -- it's not a  
6 cold it's --

7 HENRY: Like an infection?

8 DAVID: I don't know if it's an infection or  
9 not. It's just -- I don't know. It's just a -- it's  
10 kind of like you know how you feel when you feel like  
11 you're fixing to get the flu?

12 HENRY: Yes.

13 DAVID: Something like that.

14 HENRY: Well, are you sure you, are you  
15 sure --

16 DAVID: You know, you go up and down.

17 HENRY: Are you sure you don't want us to  
18 send you some medical help?

19 DAVID: No, not yet. Let's, let's --

20 HENRY: Okay.

21 DAVID: -- we're on a good road right now.  
22 That's what I've been trying to --

23 HENRY: Okay.

24 DAVID: -- that's what I was trying to work  
25 with Jim all along.

HENRY: Okay.

1                   DAVID: You know, I was trying to get a trust  
2 in him to see if he would, you know, really let me get  
3 these kids out, you know, the way I wanted to get them  
4 out.

5                   HENRY: Okay.

6                   DAVID: And he's been very good to me.

7                   HENRY: Okay. Well --

8                   DAVID: And --

9                   HENRY: -- we want to, we want to continue in  
10 that same vein. We don't want to change anything or,  
11 or make anything in such a fashion, you know. And when  
12 you kept telling me that there was somebody in that  
13 tower or in the roof, I knew that there wasn't anybody,  
14 you know, because --

15                   DAVID: We found out what it was.

16                   HENRY: Okay. Well, we appreciate, you know,  
17 we appreciate your trusting us. We continue to trust  
18 you.

19                   DAVID: (Groaning.)

20                   HENRY: We want to continue working in this  
21 fashion. I would like, I would for, you know, [gap] I  
22 would like for you to start working on that, that tape,  
23 and I will work with you, and I want you to work with  
24 me.

25                   DAVID: Okie doke. Okay. Let me get off the  
phone then. And the kids will be down there in just a

1 second, all right?

2 HENRY: Okay.

3 DAVID: Okie doke?

4 HENRY: Okay.

5 DAVID: Okay, thanks.

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 [gap]

8 \* \* \*

9 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: -- and I'm  
10 getting ready for that.

11 [gap]

13 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Hello?

14 HENRY: Hello?

15 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Yeah.

16 HENRY: This is Henry?

17 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: This is Henry.

18 Okay. Wait one moment. I'll give you to Steve.

19 HENRY: Okay.

20 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Steve. Steve.

21 Henry.

22 STEVE: Hello?

23 HENRY: Hi, Steve. Steve?

24 STEVE: Yes.

25 HENRY: This is Henry.

STEVE: Oh, hi, Henry.

1 HENRY: How are you doing?

2 STEVE: I'm on the tired side. Little bit --

3 HENRY: Oh, I guess so.

4 STEVE: -- little bit slow tonight.

5 HENRY: Okay. Couple of things I wanted to  
6 bring up. David mentioned that he was going to try to  
7 do that audiotape. Is he working on that?

8 STEVE: You know what, I, I just about 2  
9 minutes ago I was going to go lay down for a few  
10 minutes, and I went past him and he was almost snoring.  
11 He, he fell asleep.

12 HENRY: Oh, he did?

13 STEVE: Yeah.

14 HENRY: Okay.

15 STEVE: So are you working on that? Or I  
16 mean I -- or I mean have you checked or found out  
17 anything about it or --

18 HENRY: Well, he said he was going to try to,  
19 to give us a, a tape. And he had asked somebody to try  
20 to go and get some equipment from --

21 STEVE: Okay. Yeah, I, I see --

22 HENRY: -- the recording studio.

23 STEVE: I see something is here right now.  
24 So that's apparently what it's part of.

25 HENRY: Okay. Is, is he -- I really have a  
concern because he was, you know, he was in, in great

1 | pain and agony, you know, when I was talking to him  
2 | earlier.

3 |           STEVE: Uh-huh.

4 |           HENRY: And, but, you know, part of the  
5 | problem is like he said every time that he coughs or  
6 | laughs or something like that that he feels that he  
7 | starts bleeding again.

8 |           STEVE: He said that?

9 |           HENRY: Yes, he, he did. And the problem is  
10 | if he is feeling -- if there is internal bleeding, see,  
11 | when, when that coagulates, that's going to cause him  
12 | some serious problems. It's been a long time since,  
13 | since he suffered that wound, and we need to try to get  
14 | him some medical help.

15 |           STEVE: Well [gap] for, for what they're  
16 | telling me I guess -- hello?

17 |           HENRY: Yes [gap].

18 |           STEVE: [gap] Oh, something -- I don't know  
19 | what's -- what's happening I wonder?

20 |           HENRY: Yeah.

21 |           STEVE: Is that at your end or --

22 |           HENRY: No, it's probably at your end.

23 |           STEVE: Well, there's nobody around the, the  
24 | phone here. I don't get it.

25 |           HENRY: Uh-huh.

          STEVE: I'm looking around here right now.

1 | Okay. It sounds actually better. I don't know what --  
2 | it kind of cleared up or something here.

3 |           HENRY: Um-hum.

4 |           STEVE: Okay. Okay, you were, you were  
5 | saying, yeah. Oh, I tell you what. I'm just so worn  
6 | out I'm having a hard time even talking here.

7 |           HENRY: Okay. Well, let me, let me say this.  
8 | The, the two -- or the lady that brought the, the last  
9 | two kids indicated that their car is almost out of  
10 | gasoline.

11 |           STEVE: Oh, it is.

12 |           HENRY: So she said or she asked if we could  
13 | bring some gasoline on the next, you know, when we do  
14 | the next exchange. Can you get a couple of kids ready  
15 | so we can pick them up and --

16 |           STEVE: Yeah, let, let me find out then. I  
17 | guess I haven't been with it just too long here. I was  
18 | starting to lay down there and I was -- let me find out  
19 | what they're doing, and I'll try to do that, okay?

20 |           HENRY: Okay.

21 |           STEVE: Just a minute.

22 |           HENRY: Okay.

23 |           [gap]

24 |           STEVE: Just a minute.

25 |           [gap]

          STEVE: Henry?



1 HENRY: Yes.

2 STEVE: So have you made progress with doing  
3 the tape thing or --

4 HENRY: Yes. As a matter of fact, I mean we,  
5 we encountered some difficulty but, but --

6 STEVE: Yeah.

7 HENRY: What we're trying to do is because he  
8 is most serious about this --

9 STEVE: Uh-huh.

10 HENRY: -- we're trying to react in exactly  
11 the same fashion.

12 STEVE: Yeah.

13 HENRY: And what we're trying to work out is  
14 we're trying to get him some time on the National  
15 Christian Broadcasting Network.

16 STEVE: The National Christian Broadcasting  
17 Network?

18 HENRY: Yes, which has several thousand radio  
19 stations throughout the country.

20 STEVE: Okay.

21 HENRY: Now that is, is based in Phoenix,  
22 Arizona.

23 STEVE: In Phoenix, Arizona.

24 HENRY: But, you know, their headquarters.

25 But when we called out there, there's nobody there, so  
we sent agents out to go to the people's house and get

1 | them out of bed or wherever they're at --

2 |           STEVE: Uh-huh.

3 |           HENRY: -- so that we can initiate this.

4 |           STEVE: I see. So was he wanting to do that  
5 | yet tonight or --

6 |           HENRY: Well, he wanted to -- he was going to  
7 | record the, the cassette for us.

8 |           STEVE: Uh-huh.

9 |           HENRY: And then he assured me.

10 |          STEVE: Yeah.

11 |          HENRY: And I told him I was going to hold  
12 | him to his word, but he assured me not once but at  
13 | least four times --

14 |          STEVE: Uh-huh.

15 |          HENRY: -- that, that once we did that,  
16 | everybody was coming out.

17 |          STEVE: I see. Could you be careful of the  
18 | cord there? I think that's maybe what the problem is.  
19 | Someone was bumping into this -- the cord in the phone  
20 | is bad.

21 |          HENRY: Oh, okay.

22 |          STEVE: Okay. Yeah. Careful. Careful  
23 | there. Hello?

24 |          HENRY: Yes.

25 |          STEVE: Okay. Okay. Let me see. And then  
we're -- right now, he's fallen asleep. I see they

1 brought a couple of the things. Is there any way I  
2 could leave him maybe sleep for 1 hour?

3 HENRY: Okay. But, but I have a concern,  
4 Steve. And the --

5 STEVE: Yeah.

6 HENRY: -- concern that I have, you know, is  
7 that, you know, his health may be deteriorating. Okay,  
8 so --

9 STEVE: There's, there's -- right now there's  
10 a nurse over here. And she says leave him sleep for  
11 the moment --

12 HENRY: Okay.

13 STEVE: -- just to regain, regain at least a  
14 little strength here.

15 HENRY: Okay. That's --

16 STEVE: And then she said she wants there  
17 herself asking if, if they can't do something in that  
18 area. She was just whispering over here to me. So I,  
19 I think between her and I we're going to ask them about  
20 that, you know, getting that kind of attention or  
21 something, or see if there's more that could be done to  
22 help out there.

23 HENRY: Okay. Okay. And we are ready to  
24 provide that, but --

25 STEVE: Okay.

HENRY: -- we're going to have to take him

1 out of there.

2 STEVE: Uh-huh.

3 HENRY: Okay? And I want you to be thinking  
4 in terms because at some point the responsibility, you  
5 know, for the entire group is probably going to shift  
6 to your shoulders, Steve.

7 STEVE: I see.

8 HENRY: And, and, you know, I know there's an  
9 awful lot of people there. A lot of children.

10 STEVE: Right.

11 HENRY: We want to between you and us,  
12 between you and me, we need to try to coordinate this  
13 so that we can effect what --

14 STEVE: Right.

15 HENRY: -- David and I initiated and that is  
16 everybody's coming out.

17 STEVE: Okay. Is there any way then -- can,  
18 can you call me back in an hour?

19 HENRY: Sure.

20 STEVE: Oh, that would be great. Because I  
21 think what I'm going to do is even lay down here, and  
22 I'm going to have somebody here wake me up then. Or  
23 if, if the phone rings, I'm just going to make sure  
24 that I hear it just so I don't fall off too deeply in  
25 sleep or something.

HENRY: Okay.

1 STEVE: Okay.

2 HENRY: Now let me just ask you this. Can we  
3 get a couple of kids so that we can go ahead and, and  
4 give you the gasoline for that car that, that that lady  
5 was asking about?

6 STEVE: Well, she said he never -- he passed  
7 out before he gave the next couple that were to be  
8 going. So I don't know what to really do right now.  
9 Can, can we just wait for 1 hour?

10 HENRY: Okay. Does --

11 STEVE: And then, and call me and I'm going  
12 to have them at least have, you know, a number of them  
13 ready so that he can just say well, you know, these two  
14 are going next then.

15 HENRY: Okay.

16 STEVE: Yeah. I'm -- oh, I tell you what. I  
17 mean I'm, I'm so tired. Last night I went through the  
18 whole night. And I, I never got to sleep at all. I  
19 laid down --

20 HENRY: You must be exhausted.

21 STEVE: Oh, I am.

22 HENRY: Okay.

23 STEVE: Henry, thanks much.

24 HENRY: Okay.

25 STEVE: I, I mean I know you're really trying  
there. I, I can tell. And I really do appreciate it.

1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 STEVE: So I'm going to conk out here for  
3 about an hour. And please call me back.

4 HENRY: Okay. One other thing.

5 STEVE: Okay.

6 HENRY: Did you need a phone cord?

7 STEVE: I -- yeah. When you call me back,  
8 then I'll mention that again. I guess we -- I think he  
9 said that, didn't he?

10 HENRY: Yeah, but I'm not sure what kind of a  
11 cord it is that he wants.

12 STEVE: I'm not certain either to be honest  
13 with you.

14 HENRY: Okay. Okay. Well, check on those  
15 things.

16 STEVE: Okay.

17 HENRY: You know, in about an hour I'll be  
18 back to you.

19 STEVE: Thank you much.

20 HENRY: Thank you, Steve.

21 STEVE: Okay. Yeah. Bye.

22 HENRY: Bye-bye.

23 \* \* \*

24 RACHEL: Hello?

25 HENRY: Hello?

RACHEL: Hello?

1 HENRY: This is Henry. Who's this?

2 RACHEL: Just a minute. Steve. Steve. Who  
3 am I talking to?

4 HENRY: This is Henry. Who's this.

5 RACHEL: I'm sorry. I couldn't understand  
6 you.

7 HENRY: Henry.

8 RACHEL: Henry.

9 HENRY: Who's this?

10 RACHEL: Oh, it's Rachel.

11 HENRY: Hi, Rachel. How you doing?

12 RACHEL: Okay.

13 HENRY: How's everybody doing in there?

14 RACHEL: I guess okay.

15 HENRY: How's David?

16 RACHEL: Well, he looks okay. Looks like

17 he's --

18 HENRY: He looks okay?

19 RACHEL: Looks like he's sleeping.

20 HENRY: Okay. Who is the nurse in there  
21 that's, that's taking care of him?

22 RACHEL: Which nurse is it?

23 HENRY: Yeah.

24 RACHEL: I don't know.

25 HENRY: Are you a nurse?

RACHEL: No.

1 HENRY: Okay. Is there more than one nurse  
2 in there?

3 RACHEL: I think there's a few, but I don't  
4 know who, which one is which.

5 HENRY: Uh-huh. Well, you know, we have a  
6 concern. And we wanted to see if we could talk to her  
7 so that --

8 RACHEL: Looks like she's waking up.

9 HENRY: Oh, okay.

10 RACHEL: Here.

11 [gap]

12 DAVID: This Harry?

13 HENRY: David?

14 DAVID: Yeah. Is this Harry?

15 HENRY: This is Henry.

16 DAVID: Henry. Oh -- sorry.

17 HENRY: How are you doing?

18 DAVID: Okay.

19 HENRY: Are you in pain?

20 DAVID: (Gasp.) Oh, it's almost a funny  
21 question. But, oh, wait a second. Let me look --  
22 okay. All right. Are the children there yet?

23 HENRY: Yes, they are. You want to talk to  
24 them?

25 DAVID: Yeah. See. Rachel? Could you,  
could you get Larry? Is Larry asleep or -- could you



1 get Rachel, Larry and --

2 RACHEL: -- asleep.

3 DAVID: Course, little Jamie can't talk so.

4 HENRY: Um-hum. We want to confirm that  
5 you're going to be making that tape, okay?

6 DAVID: Yeah. I was just trying to get some  
7 rest --

8 HENRY: Yeah.

9 DAVID: -- to get my strength up.

10 HENRY: Okay. Okay. I can understand that.  
11 Do you -- I don't know if Steve had a chance to, to  
12 talk to you. But, you know, we're working something  
13 out. And because, because you are serious, very  
14 serious about this, we want to approach it from the  
15 same, you know, with that same seriousness. Okay?

16 DAVID: Oh, yeah.

17 HENRY: And what we'd like to do is we are  
18 trying to not present this to somebody that's, that's  
19 going to take it lightly but rather whom we are trying  
20 to contact as a matter of fact as we speak is the  
21 National Christian Broadcasting Network. Okay?

22 DAVID: All right.

23 HENRY: Okay.

24 DAVID: All right. Okay. Where's,  
25 where's -- which -- where is that located at?

HENRY: They're based out of Arizona. I

1 think it's in, I think it's in Phoenix. And they  
2 have --

3 DAVID: What's the subsidiary station here  
4 locally?

5 HENRY: That I don't know. I know that they  
6 have several thousand radio stations throughout the  
7 country. But, you know --

8 DAVID: The station everybody's listening to  
9 right now is KRLD, right?

10 HENRY: Yeah. But that's, that's local.

11 DAVID: I know --

12 HENRY: We're trying to get you something  
13 number one that's religious.

14 DAVID: Exactly.

15 HENRY: That's, that's serious.

16 DAVID: Exactly.

17 HENRY: Number two that has national  
18 exposure.

19 DAVID: Okay.

20 HENRY: Now the -- you know, as you know,  
21 that one of, one of the concerns that I have is here  
22 you are very serious, okay. And some of these people  
23 are calling you -- I don't even want to tell you what  
24 they're calling you. Okay? I mean it's something that  
25 you don't like. Okay? So I thought it would be --

DAVID: No, okay. I just -- I got what

1 | you're saying just --

2 |           HENRY: Okay. So we want to have something  
3 | that, you know, that you're going to be pleased with.  
4 | Because it's considered a serious religious network.  
5 | Okay? So we -- I mean, we called this national network  
6 | in Arizona, and we couldn't get a hold of anybody. So  
7 | what we did is we called our FBI office in Phoenix, and  
8 | as we speak they're waking up the people that are in  
9 | charge of this.

10 |           DAVID: It's not a 24-hour radio station?

11 |           HENRY: Well, I'm not sure about that. I'm  
12 | sure that it is.

13 |           DAVID: What, what --

14 |           HENRY: I shouldn't say I'm sure that it is.  
15 | But, but the people that we were trying to contact, the  
16 | head people, weren't around. So --

17 |           DAVID: Oh, I see. Yeah.

18 |           HENRY: -- so they, they sent people out to  
19 | the home. Okay?

20 |           DAVID: Right.

21 |           HENRY: And when I was talking to Steve, he  
22 | was a little bit confused about what you wanted. So --

23 |           DAVID: Okay. We're going to make this tape.  
24 | It's not going to be a long one.

25 |           HENRY: Okay.

          DAVID: And we're going to put something

1 together very tangible, very simple, very even and  
2 begin to show the difference between the way I perceive  
3 the seals and what, in, in difference to what we've  
4 heard the seals being presented thus far by all so-  
5 called teachers and religious leaders that have been  
6 calling the radio stations.

7 HENRY: Uh-huh.

8 DAVID: So that way people will be able to  
9 honestly listen and read their Bibles as they're  
10 listening and see that I know what I'm talking about.

11 HENRY: Exactly.

12 DAVID: And then they'll make a decision from  
13 what they themselves have seen and heard from their own  
14 Bible. And then like I say, then I'm in your hands.

15 HENRY: Okay. One of the concerns that I  
16 have, okay, is I'm talking to some people, some medical  
17 people. And what -- I don't like what I'm hearing.  
18 And what I'm hearing is that, you know, remember when  
19 we were talking earlier and you coughed, okay. You  
20 told me that you thought that you might be bleeding.  
21 If you --

22 DAVID: Yeah, when I cough I bleed.

23 HENRY: Okay. Now do you, do you think that  
24 you're bleeding internally? Probably, right?

25 DAVID: Well, the hole is right here next to  
the belly. And it, it hit me in the, the pelvic, and

1 | then it somehow traced around and went out kind of  
2 | towards my back. There was a hole in the back --

3 |           HENRY: (Whispering.) My God.

4 |           DAVID: -- that was bigger than the hole in  
5 | the front.

6 |           HENRY: Yeah. Well, see --

7 |           DAVID: And then the --

8 |           HENRY: What, what I'm, what I'm being told  
9 | is that when you're hemorrhaging and then you're blood  
10 | clots, okay, it creates a problem, because internally  
11 | somebody's going to have to deal with it. You've  
12 | been -- this is a long time ago that this occurred. We  
13 | need to try to move things along so that you can get  
14 | some medical assistance before you start having a lot  
15 | of difficulty, you know, and, and you start going into  
16 | shock or something like that.

17 |           DAVID: Well, I was in shock when I first got  
18 | hit I thought.

19 |           HENRY: Okay.

20 |           DAVID: But like I say when -- I'm going to  
21 | make this tape and, and I'm going to -- when we send  
22 | the kids out to you I'm going to send that tape with  
23 | them. And you'll just have to -- this will play, this  
24 | will play tomorrow sometimes, right?

25 |           HENRY: Well, we can play it whenever you  
want. If you want we can play it now. Or we can, we

1 | can go --

2 |           DAVID: Well --

3 |           HENRY: -- you know, we can play it tomorrow.  
4 | Tomorrow will be fine. Now, you know, if you have a  
5 | problem, if you have -- or if you're not happy with the  
6 | National Christian Broadcasting Network, we can go to  
7 | KRLD. I mean I don't have any problems going with  
8 | whomever you want.

9 |           DAVID: Well, that's like I say if it's a  
10 | national coverage then other stations will pick it up.

11 |           HENRY: Sure.

12 |           DAVID: And KRLD will probably more than  
13 | happy want to play it. Because they've, they've been  
14 | wondering what's happened to me anyway.

15 |           HENRY: Okay. Well, I don't have any  
16 | problems making them a copy and giving them a copy or  
17 | whatever you'd like.

18 |           DAVID: Would you, would you make a  
19 | correction for KRLD and then those things for me?

20 |           HENRY: Okay.

21 |           DAVID: Let's see. They keep saying we have  
22 | eight kids out. Let's see, we got 1, 2, 4, 6, 8, 10,  
23 | 12, 14, 16 children. And they need to, they need to  
24 | understand we got 16 children out.

25 |           HENRY: Okay.

          DAVID: And there's a whole lot more as

1 | you'll find out. And your all's records were really  
2 | wrong when you numbered the amount of people here and  
3 | stuff. And, and, you know, I'd like to hear that on  
4 | the radio that there was 18 of them gotten out so far.  
5 | That's Lahara, Renee, Angelica, Crystal, Camaray  
6 | (phonetic sp.), Landon, Jake, let's see, my eyes are  
7 | kind of blurry.

8 |           SHERRY: Ryan.

9 |           DAVID: Ryan, yeah.

10 |          HENRY: Okay. Give me the names again.

11 |          DAVID: Let me, let me get this --

12 |          HENRY: Lahara.

13 |          DAVID: -- closer to, to me. Just read it  
14 | off to me there, Sherry, would you? The, the ones that  
15 | we've sent out so far. Okay. (Unidentified voices in  
16 | background not discernible.) Okay, wait a second.  
17 | Slow down, all right? Okay. Lahara.

18 |          HENRY: Lahara.

19 |          DAVID: Okay. You already got that down?

20 |          HENRY: Um-hum.

21 |          DAVID: Renee.

22 |          HENRY: Renee.

23 |          DAVID: Okay. Angelica.

24 |          HENRY: Angelica.

25 |          DAVID: Go ahead.

          UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Crystal.

1 DAVID: Crystal.

2 HENRY: Crystal.

3 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Camaray.

4 DAVID: Camaray.

5 HENRY: Camaray.

6 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Landon.

7 DAVID: Landon.

8 HENRY: Landon.

9 DAVID: Yeah. The next one's Jake.

10 HENRY: Jake.

11 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Ryan.

12 DAVID: Ryan.

13 HENRY: Brian.

14 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Joshua.

15 DAVID: Joshua.

16 HENRY: Joshua.

17 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Jamie.

18 DAVID: Jamie.

19 HENRY: Jamie.

20 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: And --

21 DAVID: No. The other ones -- all the ones  
22 that are marked off. (Unidentified female voice in  
23 background not discernible.) Those others on the other  
24 side.

25 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Oh, Janessa.

DAVID: Okay. Janessa.



1 HENRY: Janessa.

2 DAVID: Patron.

3 HENRY: Patron.

4 DAVID: Yeah. Keep going. (Unidentified  
5 voices in background not discernible.) Let me see.  
6 Let me see that list. (Groaning.) Okay. Oh, are you  
7 saying these here are listed twice?

8 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Yeah.

9 DAVID: No, they're not. No, these are the  
10 first ones we sent out. That's why they wrote the  
11 names over there.

12 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: -- we listed  
13 them (indiscernible).

14 DAVID: No, you didn't. There's Chrissy.

15 HENRY: Chrissy.

16 DAVID: Brian.

17 HENRY: Brian.

18 DAVID: Scott.

19 HENRY: Scott.

20 DAVID: Jake.

21 HENRY: Jake.

22 DAVID: And you already got Joshua and Jamie.  
23 So that's -- (unidentified female voice in background  
24 not discernible) -- 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, -- okay, 6, 7,  
25 8, 9 -- all we've been saying anyway how many --

HENRY: I, I think we only have 14. I think

1 | you said 16, but I think we have 14.

2 |           DAVID: Oh, boy. I tell you. I mean, I may  
3 | be corrected on them. But like I say, I got a big long  
4 | list here and --

5 |           HENRY: Okay.

6 |           DAVID: -- we're marking them off little by  
7 | little and -- okay. All right. So -- (groaning) --  
8 | all right, then so I'm going to start -- where's,  
9 | where's Greg and them? They still -- where's Steve?

10 |           UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Sleeping.

11 |           DAVID: Is he sleeping around the corner?  
12 | Oh, anyway. Here, here Larry. Here's -- this guy will  
13 | let you talk to Josh.

14 |           LORRAINE: Hello?

15 |           HENRY: Hello?

16 |           LORRAINE: Hello? This is Joshua's mother.

17 |           HENRY: Oh, okay. Hold on a second. Let me  
18 | get --

19 |           LORRAINE: Okay. Thank you.

20 |           HENRY: What's your name?

21 |           LORRAINE: Lorraine.

22 |           HENRY: Lorraine? Okay. Hold on, Lorraine.  
23 | Let me get the -- Joshua. How are you doing?

24 |           LORRAINE: I'm doing fine. Thank you.

25 |           HENRY: Good.

1 HENRY: He's coming right up, Lorraine. Hold  
2 on just a second.

3 LORRAINE: Okay.

4 HENRY: (Whispering.) Say hi.

5 JOSHUA: Hi.

6 LORRAINE: Hi, honey. You doing okay?

7 JOSHUA: Yeah.

8 LORRAINE: Okay. You be a good soldier, all  
9 right?

10 JOSHUA: Okay.

11 LORRAINE: Okay. I love you, honey.

12 JOSHUA: Okay.

13 LORRAINE: Okay, sweetheart.

14 JOSHUA: Bye.

1 | to work out if, if we can is we have -- when we made  
2 | that last exchange the ladies that brought the, the  
3 | kids over said that their car was running out of  
4 | gasoline, and they wondered if we could get them some  
5 | gasoline.

6 |           DAVID: Wait a second.

7 |           HENRY: Okay.

8 |           DAVID: Said something about their car being  
9 | out of gasoline? Oh, it is? (Unidentified voices in  
10 | background not discernible.) Oh that, that little car,  
11 | you know, it goes a long ways just on a -- well, we --  
12 | she said --

13 |           HENRY: So what --

14 |           DAVID: -- that she talked to the girl, Mary.  
15 | But the thing of it is, is that -- how low is, how  
16 | close to empty is it? (Unidentified female voice in  
17 | background not discernible.)

18 |           HENRY: David?

19 |           DAVID: Yes.

20 |           HENRY: What, what we've done is we've gotten  
21 | a, you know, 5, 5 gallons worth of gasoline. We got a  
22 | gas tank full of --

23 |           DAVID: Oh.

24 |           HENRY: And when they, we make the next  
25 | exchange we'll just fill it up. We'll, we'll pour the  
5 gallons of gasoline in the car. Okay?

1           DAVID: Okay. All right. Thanks. I  
2 appreciate that.

3           HENRY: Okay.

4           DAVID: I don't -- well, it's too late to get  
5 a phone now so.

6           HENRY: What?

7           DAVID: Oh, we -- see we have a lot of --  
8 what we had to do is because I couldn't move and our  
9 phone was, was way down in a different part of the  
10 building, we had to scrounge up all kinds of phone  
11 cords and piece them together to stretch them across  
12 the building to, to get to where I am.

13          HENRY: Uh-huh.

14          DAVID: So we could have a phone here.

15          HENRY: Oh, okay, so you need a --

16          DAVID: So I had asked, I had, you know, I  
17 had sent some money to Jim, and I'd asked him, you  
18 know, to, you know, take care of the kids with that.  
19 But --

20          HENRY: Um-hum.

21          DAVID: -- I'd also asked him to if he could  
22 if he could just like have someone pick up, you know,  
23 half, you know, nothing real fancy, just a straight  
24 phone from Radio Shack or something with approximately  
25 150 feet or so of, of telephone cable.

          HENRY: Okay. Well, that's -- you know, I, I

1 have a note here to get, to get a telephone cord. I  
2 didn't know what exactly that was.

3 DAVID: Yeah.

4 HENRY: Okay. That's what you need. You,  
5 you need --

6 DAVID: Yeah. Not the, the kind that twist  
7 around and around, you know, the, the straight stuff,  
8 you know. I need a lot of it. And the longer pieces  
9 we can get the better, because then we don't have so  
10 many connections we have to make.

11 HENRY: Okay. Now you want that -- that's  
12 like, like an inside cord, right?

13 DAVID: Yes, sir.

14 HENRY: Okay. Let me work on that. I'll  
15 probably get that as soon as, as --

16 DAVID: They've got it at Radio Shack.  
17 They've got like, you know, they even got like 50 feet  
18 sections, you know. So --

19 HENRY: Okay. Let me ask you this. When I  
20 spoke to Steve he was, he was concerned, you know,  
21 about your health as we all are, okay? But he's -- he  
22 has a concern about making any decisions. Are you  
23 trying to prepare him -- do you think it might be wise  
24 to, to -- is somebody calling? Hello?

25 DAVID: Hello?

HENRY: Yeah. That is Steve -- are you

1 | working towards preparing Steve to take over some of  
2 | the responsibility? Because I feel that you're getting  
3 | weaker, okay? And, and you have a lot of  
4 | responsibility on your shoulders, okay?

5 |           DAVID: Well, that's what I was telling Jim.  
6 | I was telling Jim, I said look, Jim, I teach my  
7 | students from the very first day that they meet me I  
8 | tell them, I say hey, look, do you want to learn the  
9 | seals? And they don't even know what that is at first,  
10 | most of them. So I tell them look, would you like to  
11 | learn something about Jesus Christ --
